UPDATED INFORMATIVE DIGEST

Since publication of the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action, an emergency regulation adding section 4302 was approved and went into effect on March 4, 2022. This section provided written guidance and pictorial diagrams to assist individuals in identifying firearm precursor parts as they are defined under California law.

On April 1, 2022, a regular rulemaking was approved that adopted sections 4301, 4310, 4311 and 4312, and that amended sections 4031, 4035 and 4036. Those regulations enable firearm precursor part vendors to comply with statutorily-mandated licensing requirements for the sale of firearm precursor parts by establishing application and renewal requirements, and the timeframe for submitting permit and license information to the Department.

There have been no other changes in applicable laws or to the effect of the proposed regulations from the laws and effects described in the Notice of Proposed Regulatory Action.
