These proposed regulations and the specified associated documents incorporated by reference were originally the subject of a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking published in the California Register (Register 2021, No. 36-Z) on September 3, 2021 as file number 2021-0824-01, and the subject of a public hearing on October 20, 2021. The Department reviewed all comments received during the public comment period. In response to the public comments, and to clarify the regulations as originally proposed, on December 15, 2021, the Department posted on its website notice of modifications to the regulations and a form incorporated by reference. Public comments on the modified regulations and form were accepted until January 3, 2022. The Department has further revised the proposed regulations in response to comments from the Office of Administrative Law and to clarify the regulations, forms, and added documents incorporated by reference.
