TO: ALL CALIFORNIA LAW ENFORCEMENT TELECOMMUNICATIONS (CLETS) USERS

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform all law enforcement agencies and the courts that the California Department of Justice (DOJ), has recently enhanced the CARPOS. The enhancement includes a new order-type to allow for the entry of Canadian Domestic Violence Protective/Restraining Orders pursuant to Family Code section 6454.

When entering a record into CARPOS, TYP is the data field code used to indicate the type of restraining or protective order issued by the court. The following code is to be used in the TYP field when entering the following restraining or protective order form:

OSC Order to Register Canadian Domestic Violence Protective/Restraining Order (CLETS) Judicial Council of California form DV-630

Programming changes will be required for agencies utilizing local systems for data entry in order to accommodate the new entry type; however, the string format may be used as an alternative. If your agency utilizes LEAWEB, no programming changes will be necessary.
