

Application for Gaming Activity Review: Section III: Question & Answer

1. Name of Proposed Gaming Activity:

Bad Beat Jackpot.

2. Name each controlled game that is associated with this gaming activity:

All poker games.

3. Describe any Jackpot or any other type of prize awarded:

A Jackpot Prize will be awarded when one player in a game obtains a designated qualifying hand (“Qualifying Hand”) which is beaten by a second designated hand. To be eligible for the Jackpot Prize, players must participate in the Bureau approved game. Possible Qualifying Hands are as follows:

Option A

Bad Beat Hand (Losing Hand)	Winning Hand	Prize Amount
Any Flush or Better	Four of a Kind or Better	\$1- \$50,000
Aces Full of Tens or better	Four of a Kind or Better	\$1- \$50,000

Option B

4. If a cash prize is involved, is the amount progressive or a fixed amount?

The Jackpot prize amounts are fixed. The cash and merchandise prizes given away will range from \$1.00 to \$100,000 in the form of cash, casino chips, and merchandise to include but not limited to jewelry, electronics, clothing, vehicles, boats, gift certificates, concert tickets, food comps, entry into tournaments, and travel.

5. Explain if the gaming activity is House funded or player funded:

House funded.

6. Describe any special fee collection involved in this gaming activity, for example, a Jackpot collection fee.

7. Describe how the Jackpot will be seeded and how prizes will be awarded.

8. Explain any prize distribution including prizes given to the winner, loser, or any other player or patron.

When players obtain the Qualifying Hand and claim the Jackpot Prize, the qualifying hands will be verified by the Casino. In games that utilize hole cards, in order to qualify for the jackpot, both the winning and losing hands must use two hole cards and three board cards. After a winning hand is confirmed, the player with the Qualifying Hand will receive the posted percentage of cash or the posted non-percentage cash or non-cash prize of the posted Jackpot Prize for that game and the remaining posted percentages and posted non-percentage non-cash or cash prizes of the Jackpot Prize, if any, will be evenly distributed among all other players at the table who have participated in the qualifying table for that particular hand and/or other active players in the casino. In all instances, patrons will be provided with ample advance notice of the percentage division of the posted Jackpot Prize or the non-percentage non-cash or cash prize for the game in which they are playing. Possible payouts, prizes and percentages are as follows:

9. Explain any re-seeding of the fund once the prize is won.

All cash and non-cash prizes are funded by the house.

10. Explain any minimum or maximum number of players required to be dealt into the game for the table to be eligible for the gaming and activity prize.

A minimum of five players.

11. Explain if the house is retaining any administrative or any other type of fee operating the game activity.

The house will not retain an administrative fee.

12. Describe any opportunity(s) for the person to play for the prize without placing any live wagers or paying any table fees.

A no purchase necessary (NPN) option is available to any person who requests it. Any person wishing to participate without a purchase or live chips will have the same opportunity to play for the Jackpot Prize as the player participating in the live game. Advertisements will advise all patrons that there is a general and indiscriminate opportunity to participate in an NPN game to qualify for the Jackpot prize.

13. Provide copies of any published/proposed promotion or advertisement literature.

14. Identify any entity or person other than those licensed as the house involved in the gaming activity.

15. Describe the type of table and equipment utilized for the gaming activity.

No special table or equipment is used for the promotion. The regular tables and equipment are utilized.

Eligibility

This gaming activity will be open to all players who are seated and playing at an above listed game during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the gaming activity.

- A minimum of five players are required to be dealt in during a qualifying game in order for players to be eligible and the table to qualify for the jackpot.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the jackpot.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in the jackpot whether they are playing while they are on or off-duty. However, they are eligible to participate if they are in uniform.

- When a qualifying hand is announced, a floor person will verify that both hands qualify. Any deviation from a standard deck will nullify the jackpot.
- Players with qualifying winning and losing hands must play through the final betting round in order to qualify for the jackpot.
- In the event that during a round of play, two or more players have qualifying losing or winning hands, only the highest ranked winning or losing hands shall be awarded that percentage of the prize. The remaining players, which do not include players that received a qualifying losing or winning hand, shall receive the posted prize percentage of the table share, if applicable.
- All procedures, times, qualifying hands, and prize amounts must be displayed prominently via any form of advertising for this gaming activity that the Central Coast Casino wishes to use, including but not limited to printed flyers, digital display, the Casino's website, etc.
- Two hole cards must be part of the best 5 card poker hand for all poker games. Kickers may tie the board.
- Prize distribution, if both jackpot hands are owners, dealers, or floor people that are ON DUTY at the time of the jackpot, will be split equally amongst all active players.
- Jackpot Showdown: All live hands must be shown on the showdown. Players that muck a live hand will void a jackpot.
- Active players are defined as someone who has not missed a blind and has played at least one hand.
- Participants do not have to play live game or purchase anything.
- Players on board do not qualify for table share unless they are active on another table.

SUMMARY

Based on customer demand and industry trends, Central Coast Casino- Grover Beach (CCC) proposes to add a new gaming activity to the currently approved Poker games. The promotion will award player(s) with an instant cash or prize award for completing a line or pattern on a “bingo” card.

QUALIFYING GAMES

The following poker games will qualify for this promotion: Texas Hold'em, Texas Hold'em Hi-Lo, Lowball, 5 Card Stud, 7 Card Stud, 7 Card Stud Hi-Lo, Razz, Crazy Pineapple, Mexican Stud Poker, Omaha and Omaha Hi-Lo.

BASE GAME RULES

All base game rules that have been approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control for the poker games will be followed. There are no changes whatsoever.

PRIZE

The prize will be a fixed cash amount ranging from \$5.00 to \$5,000.00 or a designated prize with a value between \$5.00 and \$5,000.00. The monies/prizes will be awarded to player(s) who complete a line or pattern on a pre-printed bingo card after making a qualifying hand in a poker game.

FUNDING

This promotion will be solely funded by CCC. There will be no extra collection or fees of any kind assessed to the poker players.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

A person who wishes to participate in this promotion for free, on a “no purchase necessary” (NPN) basis, may do so by simply asking a CCC Floor Person. The Floor Person will provide the patron with a bingo card and set up a demonstration table. A CCC card dealer will deal the cards to the NPN player(s) and to all empty spots simulating a full game, which will give the person an opportunity to be eligible for the promotion. All hands will be monitored and played by the dealer to simulate a live game. No collection, fees, or wagers will be made at this table. All participation will be general and indiscriminate.

ELIGIBILITY

The promotion will be open to all players who play in a designated poker game. All bingo cards will be pre-printed and have a space for the date and player’s name. (A sample of the card is attached to this proposal.)

The following details are offered:

- A pre-determined number of promotional cards, similar to a bingo card, will be handed out during pre-designated times and dates. **Example:** The first five (5) players on Wednesday and Thursday will receive a bingo card while they are participating in a poker game.
- All bingo cards will have eligibility dates printed on them. The eligibility date(s) may range from one (1) day to 120 days. **Example:** Cards given out on July 1st and 2nd will be eligible for play from July 1st through July 8th.
- When a player receives a card from a CCC Floor Person, their name and date will be written at the top.
- When a player receives a card, they will be able to qualify for each hand listed on the card as they play.
- Each time a qualifying hand is made by a player, the CCC dealer will verify that the hand was made. A CCC Floor Person will then mark the player’s card with a stamp and initial that the hand was made.
- A patron will win a prize, as designated on their card, after completing a row of qualifying hands (horizontal, vertical, or diagonal).
- There may be more than one winner within each eligibility period.
- When a player leaves for the day, his/her card will be handed to the CCC Floor Person. The CCC Floor Person will place the card in the CCC cage for safekeeping.
- The CCC Floor Person will initial, date, and note the time on the back of the card each time the card is handed out or taken in for safekeeping.
- Each time the card is handed out or taken in, the player’s ID will be verified.
- Bingo cards are non-transferrable and will be destroyed once the promotion dates ends.
- Hole cards must play only when specifically noted on the bingo card.

SUMMARY

Based on customer demand and industry trends, the Central Coast Casino (CCC) proposes to add a gaming activity for the currently approved poker games. The promotion will award players, with a fixed amount of cash, who have made the recorded high hand for a particular time period.

The hand made shall be at least the advertised minimum qualifying hand. The following minimum qualifying hand options shall not be offered together at any time nor may any combination of the different minimum qualifying hand options be offered together at any time that this gaming activity is being offered. If a minimum qualifying hand is not achieved within the promotional period, no prize will be awarded. In order to qualify for the promotion, in games utilizing hole cards, the player dealt the winning high hand must use both hole cards.

Option A

Minimum Qualifying High Hand
Flush

Option B

Minimum Qualifying High Hand
Four of a Kind

Option C

Minimum Qualifying High Hand
Straight Flush

PRIZE

The prize will be a fixed amount ranging from \$5.00 to \$50,000.00 in the form of cash, casino chips, food, merchandise, travel, jewelry, electronics, clothing, vehicles, boats, gift certificates, concert tickets, or tournament entries for player(s) when they have made and such has been recorded by CCC personnel; the high poker hand for that specific time period.

FUNDING

This promotion will be solely funded by the CCC. There will be no extra collection or fees of any kind assessed to the poker players.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

A person who wishes to participate in this promotion for free, on a “no purchase necessary” (NPN) basis may do so by being at the NPN poker table at the specified time as in the live game. The NPN player must adhere to all rules as the live player.

A CCC card dealer will deal the cards to the NPN player(s) and to all empty spots simulating a full game. All hands will be monitored and played by the dealer to simulate a live game. No collection, fees, or wagers will be made at this table.

ELIGIBILITY TO WIN

This promotion will be offered whenever the CCC is open and players are participating in a poker game. All hands will be verified by the CCC dealer and floorperson. All procedures, times the promotion will be available and cash prize amounts will be displayed prominently via printed flyers, digital display, and any other forms of advertisements. The high hand will be recorded by CCC personnel and will be monitored by a CCC floorperson. Every winner will have 30 days, from the date he/she was eligible to win the prize, to claim the prize.

THIRD PARTY PROVIDER OF PROPOSITION PLAYER SERVICES

Third Party Provider of Proposition Player Services, as defined in Section 19984 of the California Business and Professions Code, will not participate in this promotion as they do not play, within their capacity, at the poker table.

BASE GAME RULES

All base game rules that have been approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control for poker games will be followed. There are no changes to the rules of the base game.

1. "High Hand of the Day".
2. All limits of Texas Hold'em, Omaha, Omaha Hi-Lo, Seven Card Stud, Mexican Poker, 5 Card Stud, Lowball, and Crazy Pineapple poker games.
3. \$5.00 to \$50,000.00 will be awarded to the player who has made and had recorded the high hand for that specific time period. All prizes will be paid in CCC chips.
4. The prize is a fixed amount. amount ranging from \$5.00 to \$50,000.00 in the form of cash, casino chips, food, merchandise, travel, jewelry, electronics, clothing, vehicles, boats, gift certificates, concert tickets, or tournament entries.
5. The activity is house funded.
6. No extra or special fees are collected.
7. The prizes will be awarded to the player when their hand has been verified and documented by the floorperson.
8. \$5.00 to \$50,000.00 cash prize.
9. The prize amount will immediately be reseeded when it is awarded to a player. A standard poker game of at least three (3) players must be involved in the game. In the event that two or more players have the exact same qualifying high hand the prize will be split equally among the players. If the prize is a non-cash prize then the cash value of the prize will be split among those players.

Tournament games do not qualify for the promotion. There is no restriction to the number of times a player is eligible for this promotion. All players shall be eligible for this promotion as often as it is offered. The winning player must be present to win. In the event that the winning player is not present, there will be no prize awarded during that time period.
