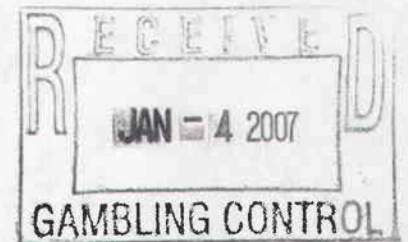

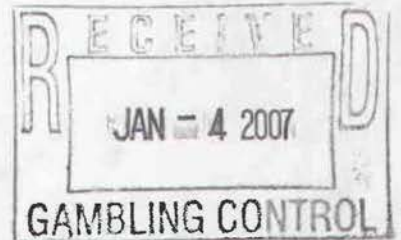

OPTIONS

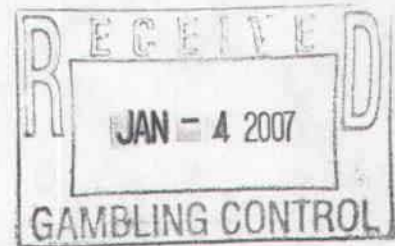

The casino may, at times add 1x, 2x, etc. the point awards during pre-posted times and/or days. This promotion will be solely funded by FLB. There will be no extra collection or fees of any kind assessed to the players.

NO PURCHASE NECESSARY

FLB Standard e-Poker Tournament

Tournament Details:

The tournament will be available upon player's request or at pre-advertised selected times from a minimum of 2 players to a maximum of 500. Do to staffing considerations, at times the 500 player maximum may not be accommodated, however every attempt will be made by FLB Casino and its staff to allow Alternates the chance to play. (An Alternate is a player who willingly begins play after another player loses his chips and is out of the tournament, thus forfeiting his/her seat to the Alternate. The Alternate list will always be on display in the order that the Alternates sign up in the tournament area.)

FLB Casino would like to reserve the option to post a guaranteed player prize pool amount from \$5 to \$500,000. The guaranteed prize pool amount will be posted before the first sign-up for the tournament is taken. The guaranteed prize pool amount will be determined by the anticipated number of players participating in the tournament along with the pre-determined buy-in amount. In lieu of cash, FLB Casino may award prize(s) such as merchandise, vehicles, tournament entry fees, buy-ins and travel expenses to other tournaments. All prizes will be at least the cash equivalent to the buy in. All Internal revenue Service guidelines will be followed. This guarantee will be used to encourage popularity and excitement for potential sign-ups.

The buy-in will be from \$0 to \$10,000 and there will be re-buys and/or add-ons. The buy-in will always be posted in plain view before the first sign-up takes place. The administration fee for this event will be from \$0 to \$1000, and will be clearly posted before the first sign-up takes place. The total cost of the tournament will be listed as Entry fee plus Administration fee. (\$100+\$15 for example; \$115 total.)

All players will start with an equal number of chips, posted before the event begins taking sign-ups, depending on what is best for the staffing and time considerations. Once the first sign-up takes place, the posted administration fee and starting chip totals will not be altered under any circumstances.

The tournament will be conducted using the Tournament Director Association (TDA) poker tournament rules. (See attached.)

The payouts for the tournament will be followed according to the Standard Tournament Payout form. This will be available to the customers upon request in addition to being displayed, with the current accurate dollar amounts, after the 3rd round of the tournament in the tournament area but before the 4th round commences. (See attached form.)

Play continues until one player either wins all the chips in play, or until the remaining players unanimously ask to evenly distribute the remaining prize pool.
