Bargain Buy-in

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Palace Poker Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Card Room advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-002235) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Bargain Buy-In Promotion.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in The Palace Poker Casino at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- The required amount a player must buy-in for and the corresponding amount of bonus chips he/she shall earn.
- The time required to play in order to retain the earned bonus chips.
- The number of participants that the promotion is limited to.
- The number of times per day a player may participate.
- The dates(s) and time(s) the promotion shall be offered.
- The games eligible for the promotion.
- Any other applicable restrictions.

Controlled Games

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion shall be attached to all limits and versions of the following controlled games, as shown below, offered at Palace Poker Casino at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Texas Hold'em (GEGA-001723)
- Omaha (GEGA-001725)
- Omaha High/Low (GEGA-001720)

Rules of Play

This gaming activity shall award players who buy-in to an eligible game for a pre-determined and designated amount with a prize of a pre-determined and designated amount of bonus casino chips. In order to keep track of the bonus casino chip distribution and time of play, a floor person shall maintain a daily log during the promotional period, which shall be used to track the time of play for each player that participates. The log shall contain the player's name, the current date, time in, time out, and the starting and ending date of the promotional period in which players may participate in the Bargain Buy-In Promotion. Each daily log sheet shall be manually recorded, tracked, maintained, and stored by the card room. It is the player's responsibility to sign-in at the start of their game with the floor manager, as well as to sign-out with the floor manager when he/she leaves. Furthermore, the player must initial their log for credit of time played.

2 hours of play is required to receive the full value of the chips. If a player wishes to cash out earlier than 2 hours then they must pay back the Bonus up to \$40 depending on which option is selected.

Bargain Buy-in

Prize

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion awards a fixed prize element ranging in value from \$15 to \$40 in the form of casino chips, as pre-determined and designated by the Palace Poker Casino. The required buy-in shall be a minimum of \$25 to \$100 in order to qualify for the bonus casino chips.

Eligibility Requirements

- The amount of required time that a player must play in order to receive the bonus casino chips shall be two to three hours of play.
- A minimum of four players are required during Poker games in order for a table to qualify for this gaming activity.
- The Casino may limit the promotion to a minimum of four and a maximum of the number of patrons who sign up during a promotional period, or a pre-determined number of qualifying participants ranging from four to 100.
- Players shall be required to fulfill the pre-determined and designated time in order to keep the bonus chips. If the player has lost all of his/her chips before he/she has fulfilled the required amount of time, including the bonus casino chips, then he/she has fulfilled the time requirement. In the event that a player has to leave before the required amount of playing time has been fulfilled, then that player shall return the entire bonus casino chip amount, or any remaining amount of chips up to the bonus casino chip amount, as long as he/she has enough left in play. If the amount of chips left in play does not equal the amount of bonus casino chips given, the card room shall not require the player to pay the difference.
- A player may be eligible for this gaming activity multiple times per day.
- Casino employees are not eligible to participate in this promotion on duty, in or out of uniform.
- Third Party Proposition Players shall not be eligible to participate in this promotion.

Funding

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion shall be fully funded by the Card Room. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate. All collection fees and table limits are for the designated controlled game and are Bureau approved, pre-determined, and posted at each table.

Administrative Fees

The Palace Poker Casino shall not retain an administrative fee for this gaming activity, as it is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Bargain Buy-In Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

High Hand Promotion

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Palace Poker Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Palace Poker Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-000928) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Palace Poker Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible game and time period(s).
- Minimum qualifying hand restrictions. In order to qualify for the promotion, the player dealt the winning high hand must use one or two of their two hole cards.
- Prize amount.
- Funding source: Bad Beat Jackpot (GEGA-001736)
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Games

The High Hand Promotion shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled game offered at the Palace Poker Casino, as shown below, at all times this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Texas Hold'em (GEGA-001724)

Object and Summary

During a pre-determined and posted time period, the player who obtains the minimum qualifying hand or higher ranking poker hand, while playing in the above listed eligible game, shall win a pre-determined and posted prize ranging in value from \$20 to \$500 paid out in live chips.

Qualifying Hands

A player who achieves the minimum qualifying hand or higher during a pre-determined and posted time period shall be awarded with the posted prize amount. The hand made shall be at least the advertised minimum qualifying hand. If a minimum qualifying hand is not achieved within the promotional period, no prize will be awarded. Furthermore, the minimum qualifying hand shall be displayed prominently within Palace Poker Casino at all times the High Hand Promotion is being offered for play. The determination of one or two cards shall be made 24 hours prior to offering the prize so that patrons have ample notice.

Minimum Qualifying High Hand

Full House – Aces Full of Twos

High Hand Promotion

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A player is eligible to win this promotion by being dealt in the game to achieve the minimum hand or better, as stated above, and have the highest ranking qualifying hand during the posted times of this promotion.
- The hand must be played to a final outcome or completion. A folded hand is not considered played to a final outcome or completion.
- In order to qualify for the promotion, the player dealt the winning high hand must use one or two of their two hole cards. The determination of one or two cards shall be made 24 hours prior to offering the prize so that patrons have ample notice.
- The hands shall be tracked on a display board in a prominent area of the Casino.
- All qualifying high hands must be verified by the Key Employee on duty in order to be eligible. Any deviation from a standard deck shall nullify the hand.
- Players with a winning hand will have 30 minutes after their name is called to claim the prize or the prize is forfeited and placed back in the jackpot fund.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the promotion.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in the promotion on or off duty, in or out of uniform.

Prize

The prize shall be an amount ranging in value from \$20 to \$500 in the form of live casino chips. If no player achieves a qualifying hand during the promotion, the prize will remain in the jackpot fund. When a player completes the highest qualifying poker hand for the pre-determined and designated time period, that player shall receive 100% of the posted prize amount. In the event two or more players have the exact same qualifying hand, the prize will be split equally among the players.

Funding

The High Hand Promotion will be fully funded from the Bad Beat Jackpot (GEGA-001736) reserve account. All collection fees and table limits are for the designated base game and is Bureau approved, pre-determined and posted at each table. There is no fee required for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

The administrative fees are collected from the Bad Beat Jackpot (GEGA-001736) gaming activity other than what is taken for the previously approved jackpot.

No Purchase Necessary

The High Hand Promotion shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the High Hand Promotion. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.

Palace Match Play Coupons/Palace Free Play Chips

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-004436) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to the Palace Match Play Coupons/Palace Free Play Chips.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for this promotion, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered:

- Eligible games and time periods.
- Coupon and/or free play chip value(s).
- Procedures to redeem coupons or free play chips.
- Any other applicable restrictions.

Controlled Game

The Palace Match Play Coupons/Palace Free Play Chips Promotion may be attached to all limits and versions of the currently Bureau approved California games offered at the Casino. All base game rules will be played as previously approved by the Bureau of Gambling Control.

Rules of Play

Patrons are awarded match play or free play coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, or winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament. Players who receive a match play or free play coupon will be eligible to win the specific amount printed on the coupon if he/she places a wager on an eligible game equal to the amount listed on the match play coupon. Players shall not exchange match play coupons or free play chips for live chips. The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a key employee.

Palace Match Play Coupon

The Casino will offer match play coupons having a face value from \$5 to \$1,000 per coupon. The amount will be clearly stated on the coupon. Each coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) that the voucher may be used on. The coupon will also state the match play coupon's expiration date. The player must place a wager equal to the amount of the match play coupon. When the player uses a match play coupon and the hand loses, the player will only lose his/her original wager and the match play coupon is collected by the player-dealer, voided and discarded. When the player uses a match play coupon and the hand wins he/she would be paid the amount listed on the match play coupon by the person in the player-dealer position just as if he/she had placed a bet. The match play coupon will be collected by the person in the player-dealer position. The player-dealer will then have a key employee sign the voucher verifying that it has been won. All winning vouchers are verified and signed by a key employee. Once the player-dealer leaves the table, winning vouchers are taken to the cage/floor podium by the key employee, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the coupon(s). If the player pushes (receives no action), the voucher may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: *A person receives a match play voucher with a value of \$5.00 that specifically states it may be used to place a wager on the Pai Gow Poker table. The person would place the voucher on the gaming table; place a bet that matches the amount on the voucher, and pay the posted collection (if applicable) for a single hand of*

Palace Match Play Coupons/Palace Free Play Chips

play. If the player wins the hand, he/she will receive \$10.00 just as if they had placed a \$10.00 bet and the player-dealer will collect the voucher.

Palace Free Play Chip

The Casino will offer free play chips having a face value from \$5 to \$1,000 per chip. The free play chips are used in live games exactly like regular chips, the difference being that they cannot be exchanged for cash.

The free play chips shall initially be in the form of a coupon which shall be offered to all patrons that wish to come into the Casino and use them to play. Patrons may be awarded free play coupons via advertisements in magazines, websites, mailing advertisements, winning a Bureau approved promotion, winning or signing up for a Bureau approved tournament, etc. When a patron receives a free play chip coupon he/she shall take the coupon to the cage/podium for verification, logging, and redemption of the free play chip(s) to be used in a live game. Each coupon shall state the specific qualifying game(s) that the free play chip(s) may be used on. The associate in the cage will then exchange the coupon for the corresponding free play chip, which can then be used for play.

Free play chips shall be used as the player's bet and placed on the betting circle. Free play chips shall not be taken into the dealer's tray, nor shall they be paid from the dealer's tray. If the player wins the hand, he/she would be paid by the person in the player-dealer position just as if he/she had placed a normal wager. The free play chip will be collected by the person in the player-dealer position. The player-dealer will then have a key employee verify that the chip has been played. All played free play chips are verified by a key employee.

Once the player-dealer leaves the table, the free play chip is taken to the cage/podium by a key employee, logged, and exchanged for the value listed on the chip. If the player loses the hand, the free play chip is forfeited and will be collected by the casino dealer and dropped in the drop box for accounting purposes. If the player pushes (receives no action), the chip may be played again until the player wins or loses a hand.

EXAMPLE: *A person receives a free play chip coupon for \$10.00 that specifically states it can be used to place a wager on the No Bust Blackjack table. The player would take the coupon to the cage or podium. Cage personnel would log the redemption code of the coupon and exchange the coupon for a promotional free play chip. The player would then place the free play chip on the gaming table, pay the posted collection (if applicable), and the game would play.*

Eligibility

The promotion will be open to all players who are seated and playing at the above listed games during the pre-determined and specified hours designated for the promotion.

- A minimum of two (2) players, a player and a player-dealer, is required to be playing in any of the games in order for the game to qualify.
- Each coupon will state the specific qualifying game(s) that a player may use the coupon at.
- Each coupon will state the match play coupon's expiration date.
- Players shall not exchange the coupons for live chips or give them to another player.
- The coupons and chips shall only be redeemed after having been played and verified by a key employee.

Palace Match Play Coupons/Palace Free Play Chips

- Casino Employees, on and off duty and in and out of uniform, are not eligible for the promotion
- Third-Party Providers of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible for the promotion.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the promotion.

Prize

The match play coupons and/or free play chips shall have a value ranging from \$5 to \$1,000 for each coupon or free play chip.

Funding

The Match Play Coupon Promotion shall be fully funded by the Casino. There shall be no additional promotion fees, jackpot fees, or collection fees taken in order to fund this gaming activity or for players to participate.

No Purchase Necessary

The Match Play Coupon Promotion does not contain the element of chance. Therefore, it does not constitute an illegal lottery and does not require a No Purchase Necessary table to be offered while conducting this gaming activity.

Palace Give-a-Way

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Palace Poker Room may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-001219) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Palace Poker Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Drawing dates and times
- Prize amounts and eligible prizes
- Amount of time per ticket
- Number of tickets that will be drawn
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity

Eligible Controlled Games

The Palace Give-a-Way shall be attached to all Bureau approved games offered at Palace Poker Room at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as approved by the Bureau.

Object and Summary

A player who participates in an approved controlled game, as listed above, shall be awarded a drawing ticket for every 2 hours of play. When a casino representative issues a player his or her live casino chips, a slip will be timestamped to show the beginning of play. After a player ends their play, a casino representative will stamp the player's slip and issue ticket(s) so he or she can fill in their name, phone number, and date. The patron shall give the ticket back to the casino representative to be initialed and dropped in the drawing bin container. The drawing ticket enters the player into a predetermined and posted drawing for a chance to win a prize with a value between \$1 and \$50,000. Players do not need to be present to win a fixed prize. The winning player will be called based on the information given on their drawing ticket. The player will have seven days to claim their prize. If a player does not claim their prize within the time period, ten more tickets will be drawn until a winner is found.

The storage and drawing bin container will be locked at all times except to draw tickets. The container lock key is kept in the cage, and checked out by a casino representative when needed. The storage container is able to spin on its axis allowing for the shuffle/mix of the tickets. The drawing tickets are eligible for only the promotional period they are earned in. Once the promotion ends, all remaining tickets are shredded.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the predetermined specified hours posted for the gaming activity.

- There is no minimum amount of players that must be playing other than is what required by the attached base game in order to be eligible for this promotion.
- Players must see a casino representative to receive their tickets.

Palace Give-a-Way

- There is no limit to the number of tickets a player may win during any given promotional period. A patron is limited to one prize per promotional period.
- The casino representative on duty will draw the winning tickets.
- Backline bettors are eligible to receive time played and participate in this promotion as long as they are playing.
- Tournament game tables are not eligible for this gaming activity.
- Casino employees are not eligible to participate in this gaming activity.
- Third-Party Provider of Proposition Player Services (TPPPS) are not eligible to participate in this gaming activity.
- A patron in the player-dealer position is eligible to participate in this gaming activity and win.

Prize

The Palace Give-a-Way features a fixed prize element. A player who plays in an approved controlled game for 2 hours will be entered into a drawing where the winner of the drawing will be awarded a prize between the predetermined and posted value of \$1 to \$50,000. Winners will have the option to claim their prize as cash or a tangible item. Example: Win a car valued at \$25,000 or receive \$15,000 in cash. If an option is made available to players, it will be predetermined and posted at the start of the promotional period. The tangible prizes shall be in the form of live casino chips, merchandise, cars, trips, hotel, or airfare.

Funding

The Palace Give-a-Way will be fully funded by Palace Poker Casino. There will be no additional fees or collections taken for this gaming activity.

Administrative Fees

There will be no administrative fees collected by Palace Poker Casino, as this promotion is house funded.

No Purchase Necessary

The Palace Give-a-Way shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. **All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Palace Give-a-Way. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.**

Poker Tournaments

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Palace Poker Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEGA-002568) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in the Palace Poker Casino at all times the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Tournament entry is open to all customers.
- How a player may enter the tournament.
- The game(s) that will be offered during the play of the tournament.
- The fees that will be charged for entering the tournament, including a description for each fee charged and whether it shall be retained by the Casino, added directly into the tournament prize pool, or any other method of retention or distribution.
- The amount of tournament chips that will be awarded to each player upon entry into the tournament.
- The tournament prize structure that will be offered and the number of players that will be paid.
- When the patron(s) will be paid and the manner in which they will be paid.
- Any other restrictions that apply to poker game tournaments.

Tournament Log

The Palace Poker Casino shall maintain all completed tournament logs for at least seven years. These logs shall be maintained in either paper or electronic format. The cardroom shall also retain and make available the most recent three months of the tournament logs for inspection by a representative of the Bureau during all hours of operation. Upon request of the Bureau, a licensee shall provide the Bureau with copies of such tournament logs. Tournament logs shall contain the following information:

- Name of Gambling Establishment
- Day, date, time and name advertised for the tournament
- Total number of tables used
- Name of controlled games offered
- Method of entry
- Number and amount of rebuys and/or add-ons offered
- Number of participants
- Name of each fee charged, amount of each fee charged, total number of each fee collected, and cumulative amount of collected.
- Source of all funds for tournament prize pool
- Amount of the prize pool
- Amount and reason for any deductions from the total collected prize pool
- Name of gaming activities offered (when applicable)
 - Funding source
 - Prize amount
 - Total number of prizes awarded
 - Total amount deducted from prize pool (when applicable)

Poker Tournaments

- Results of the tournament, including the total amount paid out and amount paid for each place in the tournament
- Printed name and signature of casino staff responsible for administering the tournament

Eligible Controlled Games

The controlled games that may be played during poker game tournaments at the Palace Poker Casino shall only be those listed below. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Texas Hold'em (GEGA-001724)
- Omaha Hi-Lo Split (GEGA-001720)

Tournament Entry

- Tournament entry is open to all customers, including off duty employees and off duty TPPPS.
- Entry Fee – will be retained by the Casino to offset the cost of operating the tournament. This fee will not be included in the prize pool.
- Tournament of Champions Collection
- Service Charge – will be retained by the Casino and used exclusively to pay tournament staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.
- House Appreciate Fee / Staff Bonus– will be retained by the casino and used exclusively to pay tournament management staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.
- The specific structure will be on any and all advertisements and must be made available to patrons prior to the start of the tournament. The structure of a tournament will not change once sign-ups begin.
- **Promotional materials will not advertise gender-based discounts nor imply a gender-based entrance policy.**
- Patrons may enter a tournament by paying the buy-in and entry fee. All fees, prices charged, and the amount of tournament chips provided will be equal for the initial buy-in and posted for all players.
- Entry may be earned by winning a previous tournament or a Bureau approved gaming activity. All gaming activities and/or promotions shall be approved by the Bureau prior to being offered for play.
- More than one method of entry for a specific tournament may be utilized.

**The Service Charge will be retained by the Casino and used exclusively to pay tournament staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.

***The House Appreciation Fee/Staff Bonus will be retained by the Casino and used exclusively to pay tournament management staff. This fee will not be included in the tournament prize pool.

****The Tournament of Champions Collection is taken from the daily prize pool and documented and kept in the designated Tournament of Champions Players bank account. The fee will go into a separate players account and tracked daily. 100% of the fee benefits the Tournament Players for future prize pool tournaments.

Tournament Prize Amounts & Source of Funds

The prizes will be the cumulative amount of buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons. The prizes may also be guaranteed. The cardroom may provide prizes or add funds to the prize pool for special events.

Regular Prize Pool

- The tournament prize pool will consist of the sum of all buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons for each tournament event, and paid cash to the winner(s).

Guaranteed Prize Pool

- Palace Poker Casino may guarantee a tournament prize pool amount, ranging in value from \$1 to \$1,000,000 in the form of cash. In this case, if the tournament prize pool paid to the player(s) from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons (if applicable) does not equal the amount guaranteed for the tournament prize pool, the Palace Poker Casino will cover the shortfall. If the total of the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons (if applicable) is greater than the amount guaranteed, the tournament prize pool will be increased by the excess funds.

Added Prize Pool

- Palace Poker Casino may add additional funds to a tournament prize pool amount, ranging in value from \$1 to \$1,000,000 in the form of cash. In this case, the tournament prize pool will be paid to the player(s) from the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons, as well as the additional monies added to the tournament prize pool.

Tournament of Champions

- Palace Poker Casino will create a separate prize pool, in which the Casino will take \$3,000 from the Separate Players Account and add it to the Prize Pool of a Daily Tournament. Players will then play for that extra cash prize in the tournament.

Palace Poker Casino may add additional non-cash prizes to a tournament prize pool, ranging in value from \$1 to \$1,000,000. In this case, the cost of the non-cash prize will be either fully funded by the Casino or reimbursed from the player(s) buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons in the amount equivalent to the cash value of the non-cash prize (including big item electronics, smart devices, and electronic games). However, if the total of the player(s) buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons exceeds the value of the non-cash prize, the excess amount of money exceeding the value of the non-cash prize will also be awarded to the winning player(s). If the total of the buy-ins, re-buys, and add-ons (if applicable) does not equal the value of the non-cash prize, the Casino will cover the shortfall.

Poker Tournaments

Tournament Prize Structure

When the prize is not guaranteed, the prize structure will be broken down by the number of paid entries and percentage paid. The percentage paid out will always equal 100%. In the event the players decide to forgo the payout structure and “split” the total prize pool among them, it shall be permitted and shall be noted in detail on the Casino’s tournament log.

Prizes will be rounded to the nearest \$5 and 100% of the Prize Pool will be paid out.

Entities Involved Other Than the House

The Palace Poker Casino shall not allow other entities to become involved in the play of poker tournaments at their gambling establishment.

Splash Pot

Bureau Requirements

Advertising

The Palace Poker Casino may advertise various names for this gaming activity. Should the Casino advertise a different name, the BGC ID (GEAR-000939) shall be referenced on all advertisements relating to this gaming activity.

Furthermore, all rules and procedures for the gaming activity, including but not limited to the following, shall be prominently displayed in Palace Poker Casino and Casino at all times that the gaming activity is being offered for play:

- Eligible games.
- Eligible time period(s).
- Availability of No Purchase Necessary.
- Procedures for “Splashing the Pot.”
- Amount to be added to the pot (prize amount).
- Any other restrictions that apply to this gaming activity.

Eligible Controlled Games

The Splash Pot promotion shall be attached to the following Bureau approved controlled games offered at the Palace Poker Casino, as shown below, at all times that this gaming activity is being offered for play. All controlled game rules shall be played as previously approved by the Bureau.

- Texas Hold'em (GEGA-001724)
- Omaha (GEGA-001725)

Object and Summary

The Splash Pot gaming activity features a promotional element attached to the approved poker games at the Casino. During pre-determined times and intervals of the promotional period, a casino employee shall “splash the pot” by adding a pre-determined and posted prize to the pot at the start of the next hand. Betting procedures and play shall proceed as a normal round of play would. The player with the winning hand shall win the pot, including the added prize amount. In the event of a tie, the winning players shall split the pot evenly.

The method for determining which table will receive the posted “Splash Pot” prize involves a drawing where a bin, basket, or other non-electronic randomizer shall be used. The cards or lamers, which are pre-printed, equally sized and colored, shall be mixed within the randomizer. During pre-determined times and intervals of the promotional period, a casino employee shall announce the commencement of the drawing. The casino employee shall then select an eligible table by randomly choosing a card or other lamer from the randomizer. Each card or lamer shall depict a number that corresponds to each eligible poker table. Once the table number is determined, the employee shall place the pre-determined and posted prize into the pot on the table, at the start of the next round of play. Betting procedures and play shall proceed as a normal round of play would. The player with the winning hand shall win the pot, including the added prize amount. In the event of a tie, the winning players shall split the pot evenly. The regular pot shall be split according to standard poker rules.

Splash Pot

Prize

When a table is selected, the prize amount shall be added to the pot of that table. The prize shall be a fixed amount ranging from \$25 to \$500 in the form of casino chips. The prize will be awarded to the player winning the hand immediately following the funds being delivered to the table. In the event of a tie hand, the pot will be split evenly.

Eligibility Requirements

This gaming activity shall be open to all players who are seated and playing at any of the above listed controlled games during the pre-determined specified hours designated and posted for the gaming activity.

- A player is eligible to win this promotion by winning the round of poker at the table number designated by the drawing.
- Tables must have five players in order to qualify for the drawing.
- The round of play will continue until a winner is determined.
- Players must be dealt in for at least one hand before the “pot is splashed” to be eligible.
- In the event two or more players tie a winning hand, the pot shall be evenly distributed between each tying player.
- There is a minimum of five players required to be playing for the table to be eligible for the drawing.
- Players who win this promotion shall still be eligible for other promotions, be eligible to win this promotion multiple times, and be eligible to win other promotions that are offered concurrently.
- Casino employees are eligible to participate in the promotion while on or off duty and in or out of uniform.
- Tournament games do not qualify for the Splash Pot promotion.

Funding

The Splash Pot gaming activity will be fully funded from the reserve account for the Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot (GEGA-001736). All collection fees and table limits are for the designated base game and is Bureau approved, pre-determined and posted at each table. There is no fee required for this promotion.

Administrative Fees

The Casino shall not retain an administrative fee for this gaming activity other than what is collected from the previously approved Bad Beat Progressive Jackpot (GEGA-001736).

No Purchase Necessary

The Splash Pot promotion shall be offered to customers who wish to participate for free, on a general and indiscriminate basis, with **no restrictions**, to patrons who wish to participate in a No Purchase Necessary game. The Casino shall provide No Purchase Necessary tables for all patrons who request to participate in the gaming activity without paying a table fee or placing a live wager. All advertisement material shall state "No Purchase Necessary" when referencing the Splash Pot promotion. This requirement extends to all forms of advertising including electronic message boards, computer monitors, posters, and flyers.
