**NOTICE OF REVISIONS TO PROPOSED MODIFICATIONS TO REGULATIONS,
ADDENDUM TO INITIAL STATEMENT OF REASONS, AND ADDITION OF
DOCUMENTS TO THE RULEMAKING FILE (OAL File No. Z2023-0228-06)**

Pursuant to the requirements of Government Code section 11346.8, subdivision (c), and section 44 of Title 1 of the California Code of Regulations, the Department of Justice (Department) is providing notice of changes made to proposed regulation sections 999.224, 999.226, and 999.228. These proposed modifications to existing regulations were the subject of a Notice of Proposed Rulemaking published in the California Register (Register 2023, No. 10-Z) on March 10, 2023 as file number Z2023-0228-06 and the subject of a virtual public hearing April 27, 2023. These further modifications to existing regulations are in response to comments received regarding the proposed regulations and for clarification purposes. Changes made after the 45-day comment period are illustrated in both the regulation text and form by orange font and double strikethrough for proposed deletions and green font and double underline for proposed additions.

Additionally, pursuant to the requirements of Government Code sections 11346.8, subdivision (d), 11346.9, subdivision (a)(1), and 11347.1, the Department is providing notice that additional documents that it relied upon, and incorporated by reference, in adopting the proposed regulations have been added to the rulemaking file and are available for public inspection and comment.
