requirements." (Ibid.) This Court finds that it is impossible and/or impracticable to meet some or all of the requirements in subdivision (a) of section 6518 of the Corporations Code. (Ibid.) The Court is also authorized, under subdivison (c) of section 6518 of the Corportions Code, to make such additional orders and grant such futher relief as it deems proper upon the evidence submitted. (Corp. Code, § 6518, subd. (c).).

- 1. Homeless and Disabled Veterans Corporation may be wound up and dissolved without meeting the requirements in subdivision (a) of Section 6518 of the California Corporations Code.
- 2. Homeless and Disabled Veterans Corporation is dissolved and its corporate existence shall cease to exist, except for the purposes of any further winding down, if needed, and to satisfy its obligations under the default judgment entered against it. The Court further orders that the duties of the directors and/or officers, or de facto directors and/or officers of the corportion be discharged, except to wind up the affairs of the Homeless and Disabled Veterans Corporation, and to satisfy their individual obligations under their respective default judgments entered against them and/or their individual obligations under their respective settlement agreements with plaintiff.
