

### CALIFORNIA CRIME INDEX, 1952-2002

#### From 2001 to 2002:

- The California Crime Index (CCI) offenses rate increased 2.4 percent.
- The violent crime rate decreased 2.7 percent.
- The property crime rate increased 4.9 percent.

*Crime in California, 2002, Advance Release* is published by the Department of Justice to provide annual 2002 criminal justice data as soon as possible. Information about crimes, arrests, and adult felony arrest dispositions is included.

This publication contains crime and arrest data reported to the Department of Justice for the calendar year 2002. It compares rates for the periods 2001 and 2002. Since 1980 marked a high point for the California Crime Index (CCI), rates for the periods 1980 and 2002 are also compared. Data for adult felony arrest dispositions are only available through 2001. The more extensive report, *Crime in California, 2002*, will be published later this year.

Data depicting crime in California have been published continuously for 50 years. The first publication, *Crime in California*, was issued in 1953 and depicted data for the 1952 calendar year.

- From 2001 to 2002, reported CCI offenses increased 2.4 percent in rate per 100,000 population. The CCI offenses have decreased 51.8 percent in rate since 1980.
- From 2001 to 2002, the violent crime rate decreased 2.7 percent. The violent crime rate has decreased 33.6 percent since 1980.
- From 2001 to 2002, the property crime rate increased 4.9 percent. The property crime rate has decreased 57.1 percent since 1980.

- From 2001 to 2002, total arrests decreased 1.7 percent in rate per 100,000 population at risk. Total arrests have decreased 36.3 percent in rate since 1980.
- From 2001 to 2002, felony arrests increased 1.0 percent in rate per 100,000 population at risk. Felony arrests have decreased 9.7 percent in rate since 1980.
- From 2001 to 2002, misdemeanor arrests decreased 2.6 percent in rate. Misdemeanor arrests have decreased 45.4 percent in rate since 1980.

As a percentage of reported adult felony arrest dispositions:

- Law enforcement releases increased from 2.9 percent in 2000 to 4.1 percent in 2001.
- Total complaints denied increased from 13.9 percent in 2000 to 14.5 percent in 2001.
- Dismissals and acquittals increased from 13.7 percent in 2000 to 13.8 percent in 2001.
- Convictions decreased from 69.6 percent in 2000 to 67.5 percent in 2001.
