Crime Down in California

The number of crimes reported for the first six months of 2009 declined in every offense category when compared to the same period in 2008.

Violent and Property Crimes, January through June 2009

Preliminary crime statistics show that violent crimes reported for the first six months of 2009 decreased 6.2 percent from the same period in 2008 (down from 62,670 to 58,810). Property crimes decreased 10.7 percent (down 205,350 to 183,415). The violent crime categories include the offenses of homicide, forcible rape, robbery, and aggravated assault. The property crime categories include burglary, motor vehicle theft, and larceny-theft over \$400. (For crime category definitions see *Crime in California* at <http://ag.ca.gov/cjsc/pubs.php>.)

- **Homicide** – The number of homicides decreased 18.2 percent from 841 to 688. Twenty-eight agencies reported increases while the remaining 57 agencies stayed the same or decreased. This resulted in a net decrease of 153 homicides.
- **Forcible Rape** – The number of forcible rapes decreased 0.6 percent from 2,781 to 2,763. Forty-one agencies reported increases while the remaining 44 agencies stayed the same or decreased. This resulted in a net decrease of 18 forcible rapes.
- **Robbery** – The number of robberies decreased 8.5 percent from 24,636 to 22,538. Fifty-three agencies stayed the same or decreased while the remaining 32 agencies reported increases. This resulted in a net decrease of 2,098 robberies.
- **Aggravated Assault** – The number of aggravated assaults decreased 4.6 percent from 34,412 to 32,821. Forty-nine agencies stayed the same or decreased while the remaining 36 agencies reported an increase. This resulted in a net decrease of 1,591 aggravated assaults.
- **Burglary** – The number of burglaries decreased 2.8 percent from 70,612 to 68,667. Forty-five agencies stayed the same or decreased while the remaining 40 agencies reported an increase. This resulted in a net decrease of 1,945 burglaries.
- **Motor Vehicle Theft** – The number of motor vehicle thefts decreased 17.9 percent from 64,294 to 52,784. Seventy-two agencies stayed the same or decreased, while the remaining 13 agencies reported an increase.

This resulted in a net decrease of 11,510 motor vehicle thefts.

- **Larceny-theft over \$400** – The number of larceny-thefts over \$400 decreased 12 percent from 70,444 to 61,964. Nineteen agencies reported increases while the remaining 66 agencies stayed the same or decreased. This resulted in a net decrease of 8,480 larceny-thefts over \$400.

Preliminary Crime Data

This report compares California preliminary crime counts for January through June 2009 with final counts for the same period in 2008. Statistics were extracted for 87 agencies serving populations of 100,000 or more. Those 87 jurisdictions account for approximately 64 percent of the crimes reported in the state

annually and provide an early indication of the crime picture for the current year. Two agencies were unable to provide a complete six months of data. To maintain comparability of the 2009 data with the 2008 data, the available statistics for these two agencies are provided but not included in the analysis of the data.

The law enforcement jurisdictions are grouped into three categories: police departments that provide law enforcement services to cities, sheriff's departments that provide services to unincorporated areas, and contract cities that contract for service rather than maintain their own police force.

The 2009 crime data used in this report are preliminary and subject to change.
