SUSPECT COMPOSITE


SUSPECT: Unknown

PHYSICAL: African American Male; 5'11" to 6'2"; 20 to 30 yrs old; thin build; short black hair (short afro).

CLOTHING: Long sleeve shirt or jacket, dark pants; black backpack.

WEAPON: None observed

VEHICLE: Dark colored bicycle which had a light colored rear fender.



OUTSTANDING FEATURES: None identified

INFORMATION: The Sacramento Police Department is requesting assistance in identifying a suspect of an attempted sexual assault on an eight year old boy.

MODUS OPERANDI SUMMARY: On March 1, 2003, at approximately 4:30 P.M., the eight year old victim was playing in front of his house when the suspect approached the victim and asked him to go across the street. When the victim refused, the suspect picked the victim up and carried him across the street to an abandoned shed, next to 3940 Branch Street. Once inside the shed, the suspect pulled down the victim's pants. The victim kicked the suspect and was able to run away. The suspect may be a transient.
