DECLARATION IN SUPPORT OF PROBABLE CAUSE

THE UNDERSIGNED HEREBY DECLARES:

- 1. That he is a PEACE OFFICER of the California Department of Justice, Pleasanton, California.
- 2. That the contents of this declaration provides probable cause to believe the above-named defendant committed the following offenses:
 - a.) One count of Penal code § 209(b)(1)
- c.) Six counts of Penal code § 368(e)
- b.) One Count of Penal code § 368(f)
- 3. I declare under information and belief that the following is true and correct:

Defendant Concepcion Giron was the Assistant Administrator at Elmwood Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Berkeley, California. In 2008 she opened bank accounts for several patients thru Citibank. She also ordered ATM/debit cards for the accounts. Over the next year she transferred money from the accounts into her own bank account, wrote checks to herself from the elders accounts, used the ATM cards, and wrote checks to petty cash from the elders accounts which she then cashed and took the proceeds. Defendant also took money from the patients' trust accounts maintained by the Center.

Defendant also convinced the son of a Victim Polk, a 77 year-old woman needing full-time nursing care, that he needed to make monthly payments of approximately \$600 cash to keep his mother in the care facility. Defendant, over a one and one-half year period, pocketed the cash payments.

In September 2008, Defendant took an 85 year-old woman with Alzheimer's dementia out of the facility and moved her into the defendant's own home. The victim, Carnell Williams, was supposed to have been taken to a licensed Board and Care. Defendant lied to friends and employees about taking Ms Williams. Defendant then used the victim's monthly pension and social security checks to pay her own bills. A friend of the victim finally moved the victim into a licensed facility.

The total loss for all of the above exceeds \$50,000.
