SECTION I. Title

This measure shall be known and may be cited as the "California Marriage Definition Act.

SECTION II. Article I, Section 7.5 is added to the California Constitution, to read:

Sect. 7:5 A marriage between one man and one woman is the only legal union that shall be valid or recognized in this state.
