California Freedom from Slavery Act

0 9 - 0 0 4 5

SECTION 1. Section 32 is added to Article I of the California Constitution, to read:

SEC. 32. (a) This Act shall be known as the "California Freedom from Slavery Act."

(b) Every resident of the State of California shall be exempt from all forms of State of California income and property taxes beginning the year following the 55th anniversary of the birth of the resident and continuing every year of residency thereafter until, and including the day of, the resident's death nor shall any form of estate tax be levied on the resident's estate.
