

The Attorney General of California has prepared the following title and summary of the chief purpose and points of the proposed measure:

REFERENDUM TO OVERTURN LAW THAT PROHIBITS THE REQUIRED USE OF FEDERAL ELECTRONIC EMPLOYMENT-VERIFICATION SYSTEMS. If signed by the required number of registered voters and filed with the Secretary of State, this petition will place on the statewide ballot a challenge to a state law previously approved by the Legislature and Governor. The law must then be approved by a majority of voters at the next statewide election to go into effect. The law prohibits state and local governments from requiring private employers to use federal electronic employment-verification systems to verify their employees are authorized to work in United States.
