

OAL Matter Type: Regular (S)

This action amends the procedure for a dealer to notify the Department of Justice ("DOJ") that the dealer has delivered a firearm to law enforcement, pursuant to Penal Code section 28050, when a dealer may not legally return the firearm to the seller, transferor, or person loaning the firearm; and adopts the procedure when a dealer may not legally return a firearm to a seller, transferor, or person loaning the firearm, for the dealer to notify DOJ that they (the dealer) has retained possession of a firearm at the request of the seller, transferor, or person loaning the firearm for a period of up to 45 days, pursuant to subdivision (f) of Penal Code section 28050, so that the seller, transferor, or person loaning the firearm may designate another person to take possession of that firearm.

OAL approves this regulatory action pursuant to section 11349.3 of the Government Code. This regulatory action becomes effective on 7/1/2024.
