TO: ALL CALIFORNIA LAW ENFORCEMENT TELECOMMUNICATIONS (CLETS) USERS

The purpose of this bulletin is to inform all law enforcement agencies that the California Department of Justice has recently enhanced the Missing Persons System (MPS). The MPS now allows for the entry, modification, and cancellation of boat records.

The new Missing Person Boat fields will only be added to the California Missing Persons System and will NOT be forwarded to the Missing Person File within the National Crime Information Center (NCIC) as NCIC does not currently allow for boats to be associated with a Missing Person Record. The Missing Person Boat Record will NOT generate a separate Automated Boat System File Control Number (FCN). Only one boat entry will be allowed per MPS FCN.

Programming changes will be required for agencies utilizing local systems for data entry in order to accommodate the new MPS Boat Record message keys. However, the string format may be used as an alternative. If your agency uses LEAWEB, no programming changes will be necessary.
