**CHAPTER 19. RACIAL AND IDENTITY PROFILING ACT OF 2015**  
**UPDATED INFORMATIVE DIGEST**

There have been no changes in applicable laws from the laws described in the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking.

After the Notice of Proposed Rulemaking, on May 11, 2023, the Department added a document relied on to the rulemaking file and made non-substantive changes to the rulemaking to delete periods for consistency and correct other spacing issues. The Department made two substantive changes to the proposed rulemaking to an example provided under the Traffic Violation data element, and the non-moving primary type of violation, and to clarify the example how an Officer can report the data element “Reason for Stop” when they do not tell the person the reason for the stop.

On July 14, 2023, the Department made further non-substantive changes to the rulemaking, including renumbering subdivisions and paragraphs, conforming the noticed text to the California Code of Regulations, and deleting section 999.224 from the proposed text since no changes were being made to that section. The Department made one substantive change to the proposed rulemaking by including data values available in a K-12 school setting, in section 999.226, subdivision (a)(15)(A).
