(January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2022)

Chapter 400, Statutes of 2013 (Senate Bill 809) amended Section 11165 of the Health and Safety Code mandating the Department of Justice to report annually to the Legislature and make available to the public the amount and source of grant funds received for the support of the Controlled Substance Utilization Review and Evaluation System (CURES):

11165.

(b) The Department of Justice may seek and use grant funds to pay the costs incurred by the operation and maintenance of CURES. The department shall annually report to the Legislature and make available to the public the amount and source of funds it receives for support of CURES.
