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Breastfeeding Support Groups: includes practices that are proven to promote, protect, and support breastfeeding.

Health Benefits Resource Center: A one-stop venue providing enrollment assistance, information and referrals for uninsured low-income residents, helping families gain access to public and private health insurance, social services and nutrition programs. It also educates residents about the Covered California program.

Meals on Wheels: In coordination with the Health Trust, provides meals for the homeless.

Physician Recruitment: Because St. Louise is in a health professional shortage area, the costs of recruiting physicians is considered a community benefit.

Director of Community Health: This person is responsible for community outreach, training providers, coordinating and reporting of all programs to the state and to the IRS.

Nursing Professional Education: Provides preceptorship for student nurses.

Health Professional Education: Provides preceptorship for x-ray and surgical technicians

Promotora Coordinator and Diabetes Education: This person reaches out to the Latino community to determine their health needs and provide referrals. Because of the high number of diabetics among the Latino population the position changed to primarily Diabetes Education.

Rotacare Lab tests: The Rotary Club maintains a clinic for the uninsured. St. Louise provides lab tests for its patients.
