## RE: Emanuel Medical Center's Request to Amend Condition VII

Dear Ms. Dickinson:
After careful consideration and pursuant to Title 11, California Code of Regulations, section 999.5, subdivision (h), the Office of the Attorney General hereby denies Emanuel Medical Center's request to modify Condition VII of the Attorney General's Decision dated January 10, 2014.

For Fiscal Year 2016, Condition VII required Emanuel Medical Center to provide a minimum charity care amount of $\$ 3,312,360$. Based upon Emanuel Medical Center's Annual Financial Disclosure Report submitted to the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development for Fiscal Year 2016, Emanuel Medical Center only provided $\$ 1,434,633$. Pursuant to Condition VII, Emanuel Medical Center is requiredto pay a total of $\$ 1,877,727$ to one or more tax-exempt entities that provide direct health care services to residents in Emanuel Medical Center's service area (19 ZIP codes), as defined on page 34 of the Health Care Impact Report, dated May 20, 2013. Please provide proof by June 30, 2018, that such payments have beenmade.
