RE: Mission Community Hospital's Request to Amend Condition XI

Dear Mr. Garner:

After careful consideration and pursuant to Title 11, California Code of Regulations, section 999.5, subdivision (h), the Office of the Attorney General hereby denies Mission Community Hospital's request to amend Condition XI of the Attorney General's Decision dated September 22, 2010.

For Fiscal Year 2016, Condition XI required Mission Community Hospital to provide charity care in the amount of \$2,424,236. Based upon Mission Community Hospital's Annual Financial Disclosure Report submitted to the Office of Statewide Health Planning and Development for Fiscal Year 2016, Mission Community Hospital only provided \$770,277. Pursuant to Condition XI, Mission Community Hospital is required to pay a total of \$1,653,959 to one or more nonprofit public benefit corporations for direct medical care to residents and homeless persons in the Mission Community Hospital's primary service area and the ZIP Codes for Inpatient Psychiatric Services as defined on pages 30 and 31 of the Health Care Impact Report dated August 13, 2010. Please provide proof by June 30, 2018, that such payments have been made.
