The Court having considered the Application of plaintiff the People of the State of California for a default judgment against defendants Association for Police and Sheriffs, Inc., a California Nonprofit Public Benefit Corporation ("APS"), Lloyd Jones ("Jones"), Shannon Ripley ("Ripley"), and Michael Marvin ("Marvin"), as well as all of the papers submitted by plaintiff in support of the Application, Plaintiff's Application for Award of Attorney's Fees Against Defendants Lloyd Jones and Shannon Ripley and Award of Costs Against Defendant Lloyd Jones

1 and supporting papers and Proposed Order, plaintiff's Complaint and the Court's entries of
2 default against defendants APS, Jones, Ripley and Marvin; plaintiff having established its
3 entitlement to a default judgment containing the relief set forth herein; and good cause appearing
4 therefore:

5 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, ADJUDGED, AND DECREED THAT

6 1. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of plaintiff against defendant Lloyd Jones in the
7 total amount of \$ 335,797.75 which shall accrue interest pursuant to Code of
8 Civil Procedure section 685.010. The judgment shall be paid as follows:

9 (a) Defendant Jones shall pay APS, or its final distributee if APS is dissolved, the total
10 sum of \$200,000.00 in damages;

11 (b) Defendant Jones shall pay the sum of \$75,000 in Business and Professions Code
12 section 17206 penalties as provided in Business and Professions Code section 17206, subdivision

13 (c) (one-half payable to the State of California General Fund for the exclusive use by the Attorney
14 General for the enforcement of consumer protection laws, and one-half payable to the Treasurer
15 for the County of Orange); and

16 (c) Defendant Jones shall pay the sum of \$ 50,000.00 in attorney's fees
17 and \$10,797.75 in costs to the Attorney General of California pursuant to
18 Government Code sections 12586.2 and 12598 to be used solely for the Attorney General's
19 charitable trust enforcement responsibilities;

20 2. Judgment is hereby entered in favor of plaintiff against defendant Shannon Ripley in
21 the total amount of \$ \$5,000.00 which shall accrue interest pursuant to
22 Code of Civil Procedure section 685.010. The judgment shall be paid as follows:

23 (a) Defendant Ripley shall pay the sum of \$75,000 in Business and Professions Code
24 section 17206 penalties as provided in Business and Professions Code section 17206, subdivision

25 (c) (one-half payable to the State of California General Fund for the exclusive use by the Attorney
26 General for the enforcement of consumer protection laws, and one-half payable to the Treasurer
27 for the County of Orange); and

1 (b) Defendant Ripley shall pay the sum of \$ 20,000.00 in attorney's fees to
2 the Attorney General of California pursuant to Government Code sections 12586.2 and 12598 to
3 be used solely for the Attorney General's charitable trust enforcement responsibilities;

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED THAT

5 3. Defendant Jones is permanently enjoined from controlling or directing the operations
6 and affairs of any California nonprofit public benefit corporation until he fully accounts to the
7 Attorney General for all funds received by, and disbursed from, any and all financial accounts of
8 APS during the period of January 1, 2005 to May 29, 2009;

9 4. Defendant Jones and defendant Ripley are permanently enjoined from engaging in
10 unfair competition;

11 5. Defendant Michael Marvin is permanently enjoined from soliciting any donations from
12 California residents until such time as he has filed complete and accurate annual reports and fully
13 complied with California's registration requirements;

14 6. APS is hereby dissolved and its corporate existence forfeited;

15 7. The California nonprofit public benefit corporation Laura's House is hereby appointed
16 as final distributee of APS' assets. All assets currently due and owing to APS, if any, shall be
17 distributed to Laura's House; all assets due to APS in the future, if any, shall be distributed to
18 Laura's House;

19 8. The liability of APS to creditors, if any, is not discharged;

20 9. The liability of defendants Lloyd Jones and Shannon Ripley as alleged in *People v.*
21 *Association for Police and Sheriffs, Inc., et al.*, case number 30-2009-00123781, is not discharged
22 except as provided in this Judgment, nor is any other liability of Lloyd Jones and Shannon Ripley
23 discharged as to any person or entity;

24 10. The liability of the directors and officers and former directors and officers of APS
25 (other than defendants Lloyd Jones and Shannon Ripley), if any, is not discharged except, as to
26 Calvin Butler, Jr., claims arising from the allegations set forth in the Complaint in this action, are
27 discharged; and
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11. The Court shall retain jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter of this action in order to enforce this Judgment.
