Plaintiff, the People of the State of California, represented by California Attorney General's Office, filed a request for an order involuntarily dissolving defendant Homeless and Disabled Veterans Corporation, a California nonprofit public benefit corporation. On September 10, 2010, this matter properly came before this Court for a hearing.

GOOD CAUSE APPEARING, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED:

Under subdivision (b), section 6518 of the Corporations Code, "[i]n an action brought by, and at the request of, the Attorney General, the court may make an order declaring that a corporation is wound up and dissolved without meeting the requirements in subdivision (a), upon a finding by the court that it is impossible or impracticable to meet some or all of those


1 requirements." (*Ibid.*) This Court finds that it is impossible and/or impracticable to meet some or
2 all of the requirements in subdivision (a) of section 6518 of the Corporations Code. (*Ibid.*) The
3 Court is also authorized, under subdivision (c) of section 6518 of the Corporations Code, to make
4 such additional orders and grant such further relief as it deems proper upon the evidence
5 submitted. (Corp. Code, § 6518, subd. (c)).

6 1. Homeless and Disabled Veterans Corporation may be wound up and dissolved
7 without meeting the requirements in subdivision (a) of Section 6518 of the California
8 Corporations Code.

9 2. Homeless and Disabled Veterans Corporation is dissolved and its corporate
10 existence shall cease to exist, except for the purposes of any further winding down, if needed, and
11 to satisfy its obligations under the default judgment entered against it. The Court further orders
12 that the duties of the directors and/or officers, or de facto directors and/or officers of the
13 corporation be discharged, except to wind up the affairs of the Homeless and Disabled Veterans
14 Corporation, and to satisfy their individual obligations under their respective default judgments
15 entered against them and/or their individual obligations under their respective settlement
16 agreements with plaintiff.
