

In California, you may be a victim of a hate crime if a crime was committed against you because of your actual or perceived:



- **Race or ethnicity**
- **Nationality**
- **Religion**
- **Gender**
- **Sexual orientation**
- **Physical or mental disability**
- **Association with a person or group with one or more of these actual or perceived characteristics**
