

#### From **2000** to **2001**:

- The California Crime Index (CCI) offenses rate increased 3.7 percent.
- The violent crime rate decreased 0.8 percent.
- The property crime rate increased 6.0 percent.

*Crime and Delinquency in California, 2001, Advance Release* is published by the Department of Justice to provide annual 2001 criminal justice data as soon as possible. Information about crimes, arrests, and adult felony arrest dispositions is included.

This publication contains crime and arrest data reported to the Department of Justice for the calendar year 2001. It compares rates for the periods 2000 and 2001. Since 1980 marked a high point for the California Crime Index (CCI), rates for the periods 1980 and 2001 are also compared. Data for adult felony arrest dispositions are only available through 2000. The more extensive report, *Crime and Delinquency in California*, 2001, will be published later this year.

Data depicting crime in California have been published continuously for 49 years. The first publication, *Crime in California*, was issued in 1953 and depicted data for the 1952 calendar year.

- From 2000 to 2001, the property crime rate increased 6.0 percent. The property crime rate decreased 59.1 percent since 1980.

- From 2000 to 2001, total arrests decreased 2.3 percent in rate per 100,000 population at risk. Total arrests have decreased 35.2 percent in rate since 1980.
- From 2000 to 2001, felony arrests increased .8 percent in rate per 100,000 population at risk. Felony arrests have decreased 10.6 percent in rate since 1980.
- From 2000 to 2001, misdemeanor arrests decreased 3.9 percent in rate per 100,000 population at risk. Misdemeanor arrests have decreased 44.0 percent in rate since 1980.

<sup>1</sup> Status offenses include truancy, incorrigibility, running away, and curfew violations. These offenses can only be committed or engaged in by a juvenile.

#### As a percentage of reported adult felony arrest dispositions:

- Law enforcement releases decreased from 3.5 percent in 1999 to 2.9 percent in 2000.
- Total complaints denied decreased from 14.4 percent in 1999 to 13.9 percent in 2000.
- Dismissals and acquittals increased from 12.9 percent in 1999 to 13.7 percent in 2000.
- Convictions increased from 69.2 percent in 1999 to 69.6 percent in 2000.
