Re: CRIME STATISTICS - PENAL CODE SECTION 13023.5 (AB561)

Mr. Dann:

This letter is to provide statistical information regarding arrests made by the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department, where private information of the victim was gathered from the internet and used in the furtherance of the crime. This report is provided as mandated by Penal Code Section 13023.5(b). The focus of this data is on crimes in which the victim was a minor.

From January 1, 2013, through June 24, 2013, the Los Angeles County Sheriff's Department had 670 cases where an arrest was made and there was a minor victim. There were a total of 863 minor victims identified, and 881 persons arrested. Of these cases, there were only four cases where a minor victim's "private information" was obtained via the internet and used in the furtherance of the crime.
