Short-Barreled Shotgun/Short-Barreled Rifle Report of Inventory, Acquisitions, Dispositions, Manufacture INSTRUCTIONS

Requirements:

The Short-Barreled Rifle Permit holder (permittee) must maintain current records of inventory, acquisitions, dispositions, and manufacture of short-barreled shotguns and/or short-barreled rifles possessed and/or manufactured in California (Subdivision (a) of Section 4130 of Article 3 of Chapter 12.5 of Division 1 of Title 11 of the California Code of Regulations (11 CCR 4130(a)). Current records must be maintained on this form, or a computer generated printout of the same format (11 CCR 4130(a)(1)). The permittee must make these records available to any peace officer or other persons designated by the Attorney General upon request (11 CCR 4130(h)).

The short-barreled shotgun/short-barreled rifle permittee must also submit to the Department of Justice (DOJ) an annual report of inventory, acquisitions, dispositions, and manufacture of short-barreled shotguns and/or short-barreled rifles possessed and/or manufactured in California on this form, or a computer generated printout of the same format. The annual report shall present all short-barreled shotguns and/or short-barreled rifles possessed by the permittee at any time during the reporting term. All acquisitions, dispositions, manufacture, and lost or stolen short-barreled shotguns and/or short-barreled rifles, and all short-barreled shotguns and/or short-barreled rifles in continued possession from the prior permit term must be reported. The annual report must be submitted to DOJ with the annual Dangerous Weapons License/Permit(s)Renewal Application, Form BF 031, (11 CCR 4130(a)(2)). Or, upon termination of the permit, a final report detailing disposition of all short-barreled shotguns and/or short-barreled rifles must be submitted to DOJ.

Completing the Short-Barreled Shotgun/Short-Barreled Rifle Report Form:

The form provides three entry sections for reporting up to three separate weapons. Make as many copies of this form as required to complete your reporting requirement. Place a sequential Entry Number in the indicated space for each reported short-barreled shotgun or short-barreled rifle. The weapon description line (first line of each entry section) must be completed for all entries. In the Entry Type space, place "S" for a short-Barreled Shotgun or "R" for a short-barreled rifle entry. Enter the make, model, serial number, and caliber in the respective spaces.

Complete the acquisition line (second line of each entry section) for all weapons acquired since completion of the last annual report (for new permittees, report all short-barreled shotguns/short-barreled rifles acquired since issuance of the new permit). For Acquisition Type, report "A" for acquired from a transferor or "M" for manufactured. In the respective spaces, enter the date acquired and transferor's name. For Transferor Type, enter "D" for a California short-barreled shotgun/short-barreled rifle permittee, "F" for an out-of-state Federal Firearms Licensee (FFL), or "L" for a law enforcment agency (for trade-ins). In the respective space, enter the transferor's dangerous weapons permit number whenever the transferor is a California dealer or an out-of-state transferor's FFL number.

Complete the disposition line (third line of each entry section) for all weapons disposed since completion of the last annual report (for new permittees, reports of all short-barreled shotguns/short-barreled rifles disposed since issuance of the new permit). For Disposition Type, indicate "T" for a transfer or "S" for stolen or lost. In the respective spaces, enter the date of disposition and transferee's name. For Transferee Type, enter "D" for short-barreled shotgun/short-barreled rifle permittee, "L" for law enforcement agency, or "M" for military agency. In the respective space, enter the transferee's rank and contact telephone number.

On the bottom line of the form, enter your short-barreled shotgun/short-barreled rifle permit number; your reporting period, which must be either continuous with or incorporating previous annual reports; and current page number as well as total number of pages of the report.
