Any active duty military personnel may apply for a DOJ Assault Weapon Permit for personal possession and/or transportation of assault weapons during the course of permanent stationing in the State of California while on active military duty. The permit can only be granted under the express conditions of Title 11, Div 5 4130(g) of CA Code of Regulations.

Requirements for Assault Weapon Permit for active military personnel (original application):

- Completed Application (BOF 4082)
- Completed Request for Live Scan Service (BCII 8016)
- · Current copy of applicant's official military identification card
- Official letter signed by the applicant's Base Commander, establishing that
 a bona fide necessity exists for use of personal assault
 weapons in sanctioned military activities. The letter must include a
 current telephone number for the Base Commander's office.
- Copy of Permanent Change of Military Station Orders

Assault Weapon Permits for active military personnel permits may be renewed annually, as long as the permit holder is permanently stationed in the State of California on active military duty and a bona fide necessity still exists for use of personal assault weapons in sanctioned military activities. Requirements for renewal:

- Military Assault Weapon Permit Renewal Application (DOJ mails this to you sixty days prior to the permit expiration date).
- Current copy of applicant's official military identification card
- Official Letter signed by the applicant's Base Commander, establishing that a bona fide necessity exists for use of personal assault weapons in sanctioned military activities. The letter must include a current telephone number for the Base Commander's office.
- Copy of Permanent Change of Military Station Orders
- There is no renewal fee if the renewal application is received by DOJ prior to the expiration date of the current permit. A late fee of \$25 will be imposed on renewal applications received after the application renewal due date.

Completed copy of the Report of Use of Personal Assault Weapons in Military Sanctioned Activities (BOF 047).

DOJ will not issue a permit renewal until it receives all of the required documentation and the applicable fees.
