

Let It Ride

Options Sheet

Cardrooms that would like to offer Let It Ride must fill out and submit this sheet along with all other requirements as stated in the BGC Standard Game Rules Instruction Sheet. The following options are available for individual cardrooms to cater to the needs of their customers:

Backline Betting Options: If a cardroom wishes to offer backline betting, please check the appropriate box below. **Please check only one box.**

Action Button Options – Please check only one box.

No Action Button Utilized – Both the deal and settling of wagers will start with the player to the left of the player-dealer and continue in a clockwise manner.

Action Button Utilized - The game utilizes an action button to determine which player receives first action on their wager. The player-dealer shakes a dice cup, which contains three dice, and the numerical total of the three dice determines the position of the action button. The player-dealer's position is always one, nine, and seventeen. Other seats, in clockwise rotation around the table, respectively represent the other numbers. If the numerical total of the dice are one, nine, or seventeen, the player-dealer shall receive the first set of cards, regardless of how many players are seated, and the player to the right of the house dealer shall receive the action button.
