- 2. If the applicant was born outside the United States, proof of employment eligibility (e.g., front and back copy of Resident Alien Card, Certificate of Naturalization, Passport, or other Immigration and Naturalization Service paperwork)

Note: During the investigation by the State Gaming Agency, additional documentation and/or information may be required from the applicant.
