OMAHA HIGH-LOW

Omaha is a form of Texas Hold'em, except the players are dealt 4 down cards (hole cards) as their initial starting hand.

Two players to the left of the dealer button post blinds.

The Play

The action starts with the first player in front of the big blind (clockwise). There are 3 other betting rounds; the flop, the turn, and the river. The five board cards are community cards and belong to all active players. Players must use exactly 2 cards from their 4-card hand (hole cards) and 3 cards from the board (community cards) to produce their best 5-card hand. The hole cards and the board cards are interchangeable for high or low. To win the low half, the player must have an 8 or better to qualify, or the high hand wins the entire pot.

A bet and 3 raises are allowed.

Check and raise are permitted.

LOWBALL

Lowball is draw poker with the lowest hand winning the pot. Each player receives five cards dealt face down after which there is a round of betting. Since Lowball has a blind players are required to either bet or fold, checking is not permitted before the draw. Players who remain in the pot have the option of improving their hand by discarding any of the cards in their hand and replacing them with new ones. This is called the "draw".

RULES

1. Cards Speak for themselves, however verbal declarations are binding, this means that if a player announces a hand 8 for instance, that player must be able to produce an 8 or better in order to win. If a you miscall your hand and cause another to foul their hand, your hand is dead.
2. In Lowball the best hand is 5-4-3-2-A. Straights and flushes have no value but neither do they count against your hand.
3. The joker is the lowest not already in your hand.
4. A new player has two options. To wait for the blind or to kill the pot (double the limit for that hand).
5. Half a blind or more constitutes a full blind.
6. A player who has less than half the blind may receive a hand and the next player must take the blind. If the all-in player wins the pot or rebuys he must then take the blind.
7. If you miss your blind you may only be dealt in on your next blind.
8. Before the draw an exposed card of seven or under must be taken, and an exposed card higher than seven must be replaced after the deal is completed. After the draw an exposed card cannot be taken and must be replaced after the draw has been delivered to each player in turn.
9. A flashed card before the draw is not considered an exposed card. After the draw all exposed cards must be replaced.
10. A player may draw up to five cards to improve their hand.

11. Upon showdown a player must produce five cards to have a playing hand; more or fewer than five cards constitutes a dead hand. Before the draw if you have fewer than five cards and no action has been taken by the first player to act, you may receive additional cards, unless the action is taken before the deal is completed. However, the dealer button may still receive cards even if action has taken place. If action has taken place you may receive the number of cards necessary to complete your hand on the draw.
12. You may change the number of cards you requested only if:
 - a. No player has acted on their hand based on the number of cards you drew.
 - b. No cards have been dealt off the deck in response to your request this includes the burn card
13. If you are asked how many cards you drew by an active player you are obligated to respond, unless action has taken place after the draw. The dealer is also obligated to respond. If action has taken place after the draw you are no longer obligated to respond and the dealer cannot respond.
14. The minimum opening bet is the amount of the big blind.
15. Check and raise is not permitted.
16. A bet and six raises is allowed in multihanded games. In a heads up situation there is no limit to raises.
17. Rapping the table in turn constitutes a pat hand or a check, depending on the situation.
18. You must bet a seven. If you check a seven and it is the best hand, you are not entitled to win any of the action after the draw. You are still eligible to win whatever existed in the pot before the draw provided you have the best hand.

TEXAS HOLD'EM RULES

OBJECT OF THE GAME

Obtain the highest ranking hand to win the pot. The dealer button rotates clockwise after each hand.

The game is played with a standard deck of 52 cards (No Joker).

The deck consists of four suites:

Spades
Hearts
Diamonds
Clubs

The suites are all equal value. Each suite has 13 cards. Ranking from highest to lowest are:

Ace
King
Queen
Jack

10,9,8,7,6,5,4,3,2, and Ace = 1

(Note: An Ace may be played high or low for a 5-card straight.)

A-2-3-4-5 = Low Straight
10-J-Q-K-A = High Straight

RANK OF HANDS:

Royal Flush
Straight Flush
Four of a Kind
Full House
Flush
Straight
Three of a Kind
Two Pair
One Pair
High Card

TEXAS HOLD'EM RULES

A player may chose any combination from the 7 total cards to make a 5-card hand.

Example: The players may play the 5 cards on the board or use 1 card from their hand and 4 cards on the board, or use both cards from their hand and 3 cards from the board,

A bet and 3 raises are allowed.

Check and raise are permitted.
