**(CORRECTED) NOTICE OF EXTENSION OF THE 15-DAY PUBLIC  
COMMENT PERIOD FOR MODIFICATION OF TEXT OF PROPOSED  
REGULATION**

On February 16, 2016, the Department of Justice (DOJ) issued a notice extending the 15-day comment period in its rulemaking to amend parts of the regulations set forth in California Code of Regulations, title 11, sections 3000 through 3008 and sections 3201 through 3204, and to renumber section 3204 as section 3205. The notice erroneously stated that the public comment period on the Modification of Proposed Regulation, issued on February 4, 2016, is extended to *November 26, 2016*. The notice should have stated that the public comment period is extended to **February 26, 2016, at 5:00 p.m.**

These amendments would affect settlement terms, penalty amounts, and attorney's fees in civil actions filed by private persons in the public interest pursuant to the Safe Drinking Water and Toxic Enforcement Act of 1986 ("Proposition 65"), codified at Health and Safety Code §§ 25249.5-25249.13; § 25180.7; and § 25192.
