CAPSS Release Notes: June 2016

On June 15, 2016 changes were made to the CAPSS system allowing for more user- friendly functionality. Below are the major points outlining the most recent changes:

- A link has been added to the CAPSS Welcome Page to provide the user with the latest release notes and Information
- Fixed a bug in the system which resulted in multiple license expiration emails being sent daily. Users will receive an email reminder at the 60, 30 and 10 day milestone
- The API Proposal document has been posted on the Attorney General's Public Internet Website

Next Planned Release:

The following changes will be included in the next release tentatively scheduled to be delivered no sooner than Mid-August 2016.

New Article

- The DOJ article table will continue to be utilized for the online form and the xml bulk upload; however, if the new article is not on the table, users may type in the full name of the article and submit
- CAPSS team will review new articles and determine if they require tabling
- New articles added to CAPSS will be updated to the Article Table on a weekly basis and available on the AG's Public Internet website

Customer Identification:

- The 10 year date validation will be removed from the Date of Issue for all ID types
- Dates submitted must be in the correct date format (mm/dd/yyyy or for bulk uploads mm-dd-yyyy) or blank
- The Expiration Year must be a 4 digit number or blank
- Date of Issue must be prior to or in same year of Expiration
- If the customer ID utilized does not contain a Date of Issue or Expiration Year one or the other may be left blank, however <u>both fields cannot be blank</u>
- Addition of "OTHER" will be included in the list of ID types
- If using "OTHER" ID type the State and Country data fields may be left blank or if entered will be validated against respective state and country tables

Miscellaneous:

- The Property Description field will be expanded to allow for 300 characters
- The updated XML specifications will be available on the AG's website soon

Meetings:

The most recent webinar was held on June 1, 2016 which was a follow-up meeting to the April 27th Teleconference. Included in this discussion were the comments and feedback received from the CAPSS users.

Next API meeting will be tentatively scheduled for July.
