SUSPECT COMPOSITE - Case # 04-64733

EVENT: Homicide of adult female

DATE: Friday, December 10, 2004, approximately 2:00pm

LOCATION: Sandman Park - Stockton, California

INFORMATION: The above three sketches are from different witnesses describing the SAME ADULT MALE SUBJECT who was seen on the levee and foot bridge near Wagner Holt School and Sandman Park on the day of the homicide. The male subject was last seen leaving the area in a dark green colored 4-door SUV, possibly with tinted windows.

SUBJECT DESCRIPTION: White or Hispanic male, 30-38 years old, approximately 6'1", medium build, short brown hair, with slight mustache and goatee. He was last seen wearing a dirty white baseball cap, tan or green colored trench coat, grey sweat pants, white tennis shoes and a white T-shirt.
