Collection and Use of Personal Information. Providing Personal Information Is Voluntary. You do not have to provide the personal information requested. If you do not wish to provide personal information, such as your name, home address, or home telephone number, you may remain anonymous. In that case, however, we may not be able to contact you or help resolve your complaint.

Access to Your Information. You may review the comment or complaint that you submitted to DOJ as permitted by the Information Practices Act.

Possible Disclosure of Personal Information. In order to follow up on your complaint, we may need to share the information you give us with the party you complained about or with other government agencies.

The information you provide may also be disclosed in the following circumstances:

- -With other persons or agencies where necessary to perform their legal duties, and their use of your information is compatible and complies with state law, such as for investigations or for licensing, certification, or regulatory purposes;
- -To another government agency as required by state or federal law;
- -For law enforcement or investigative purposes, including the investigation and prosecution of violations of federal, state or local laws.
- -For purposes of litigation-related investigations by DOJ or other state agencies.
