Prudential provides, or in the past did provide, group life insurance to you as a result of your employment relationship with Unisys. I am writing to let you know that a Prudential associate made a clerical error and inadvertently emailed a document containing information relating to your insurance relationship with us, including your name, address, date of birth, Social Security number, and salary information, to another individual at Unisys. This occurred on December 13, 2012. The recipient notified the Prudential associate immediately and notified Unisys management, which also notified Prudential. The recipient has deleted the document as well.

We have no reason to believe that the information about you has been used improperly or inappropriately or that you are at risk for identity theft because of this matter. Nonetheless, we are sending you this letter because we take our responsibility to safeguard personal information seriously, and we wanted to make you aware of the situation. We have made arrangements to provide you with a two-year complimentary membership in Equifax Credit Watch™ Gold with 3-in-1 Monitoring identity theft protection, a program that monitors your credit file and notifies you of certain activity. The enclosed sheet provides instructions for enrollment and should you choose to enroll, please use the following promotion code **XXXXXXXXXX**, which will be valid for your use through May 31, 2013.

There are other steps you can take to further protect yourself against identity theft or other unauthorized use of personal information if you are concerned.

- We recommend that you remain vigilant and regularly review your account statements and credit reports for any unauthorized activity. Promptly report incidents of suspected identity theft or fraud to your local law enforcement agency, the Federal Trade Commission, your financial institution and to one of the three nationwide consumer reporting agencies listed below to have it removed from your credit file.
- You may contact the fraud departments of the three nationwide credit reporting agencies to discuss your options. You have the right to place a free 90-day fraud alert on your credit file. A fraud alert lets creditors know to contact you before opening new accounts. It also may delay your ability to obtain credit. To place a fraud alert on your credit report contact the three credit reporting agencies below. You may obtain additional information from these credit reporting agencies and the Federal Trade Commission regarding fraud alerts and security freezes.

You may want to obtain copies of your credit report to ensure the accuracy of the report information.

How to Enroll

Equifax has a simple Internet-based verification and enrollment process that you can use, or you may enroll by calling the toll-free telephone number below. **In either case, you will need to use the code from the attached cover letter**, which will be valid for your use through Date.

- To sign up online for **online delivery** go to www.myservices.equifax.com/tri
Consumer Information: complete the form with your contact information (name, address and e-mail address) and click “Continue” button. The information is provided in a secured environment.
- Identity Verification: complete the form with your Social Security Number, date of birth, telephone number, create a User Name and Password, agree to the Terms of Use and click “Continue” button. The system will ask you up to two security questions to verify your identity.
- Payment Information: During the “check out” process, enter the promotion code, provided at the top of your letter, in the “Enter Promotion Code” box. After entering your code, press the “Apply Code” button and then the “Submit Order” button at the bottom of the page. (This code eliminates the need to provide a credit card number for payment.)
- Order Confirmation: – Click “View My Product” to access your 3-in-1 Credit Report and other product features.

To sign up for **US Mail delivery**, dial 1-866-937-8432 for access to the Equifax Credit Watch automated enrollment process. Note that all credit reports and alerts will be sent to you via US Mail only.

1. Promotion Code: You will be asked to enter your promotion code as provided at the top of your letter (**do not include the dash or any spaces**)

2. Customer Information: You will be asked to enter your home telephone number, home address, name, date of birth and Social Security Number.
3. Permissible Purpose: You will be asked to provide Equifax with your permission to access your credit file and to monitor your file. Without your agreement, Equifax cannot process your enrollment.
4. Order Confirmation: Equifax will provide a confirmation number with an explanation that you will receive your Fulfillment Kit via the US Mail (when Equifax is able to verify your identity) or a Customer Care letter with further instructions (if your identity cannot be verified using the information provided). Please allow up to 10 business days to receive this information.
