NOTICE OF DATA BREACH

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that ActVnet, our web-based Emergency Response System funded and developed by Tulare County Office of Education ("TCOE"), had an unauthorized disclosure involving your staff data. On Thursday March 20, 2025, the District received an email from TCOE that they became aware of a disclosure of Personally Identifiable Information ("PII"). A member of their staff inadvertently distributed a list of Fipps Primary School and Central Valley Preschool staff and student information to two staff members of Lone Pine Unified School District.
Staff names, emails, and mobile numbers and student names, date of birth, grade, emergency contact names and phone numbers, and teachers' names.
While there is no evidence to suggest that your data was misused, state law mandates that we notify our families of those whose data may have been subject to unauthorized access. (See Cal. Civ. Code § 1798.29; see also Cal. Gov. Code § 6252.) The District has confirmed that no Social Security Numbers or financial information was disclosed during the event. We have also been advised that the email and its content have been deleted.
There is nothing to suggest that any data was accessed revealing Social Security numbers, credit card numbers, financial account information, or other information directly impacting your credit rating. Nevertheless, If you suspect your personal information has been misused, visit the FTC's site at LdentityTheft.gov to get recovery steps and to file an identity theft complaint. Your complaint will be added to the FTC's Consumer Sentinel Network, where it will be accessible to law enforcers for their investigations.
TCOE said they are taking all precautions to prevent future security breaches from occurring.
