**Subject:** Notice of Data Breach

Dear Valued Client,

We are writing to inform you of a recent data security incident that may have involved certain personal information related to your legal matter with **Bridgewater Law Group**. Protecting our clients' privacy and confidentiality is of the utmost importance to us, and we take this matter very seriously.

**WHAT HAPPENED** On or about December 24, 2025, Bridgewater Law Group identified suspicious activity within our computer systems. Upon discovery, we promptly took steps to secure our systems and initiated a comprehensive investigation with the assistance of leading cybersecurity professionals and local authorities. The investigation determined that an unauthorized third party may have accessed or acquired certain data stored within our systems.

**WHAT INFORMATION MAY HAVE BEEN INVOLVED** Based on our investigation to date, the information potentially involved may have included some combination of the following, depending on the individual:

- Name and contact information
- Case-related documents
- Medical records or medical information obtained in connection with your legal representation
- Social Security Number (if provided to us for your case)

At this time, we have no evidence that your information has been misused, but we are providing this notice out of an abundance of caution and in compliance with applicable state and federal laws.

**WHAT WE ARE DOING** Bridgewater Law Group has taken and continues to take all appropriate and legally required steps to address this incident, including:

- Immediately securing our systems and implementing additional technical safeguards.
- Engaging third-party cybersecurity experts to investigate and remediate the issue.
- Reviewing and strengthening internal data protection and access controls.
- Notifying appropriate regulatory authorities and law enforcement as required by law.

We are offering **12 months of complimentary credit monitoring and identity restoration services**. Please contact us on how to enroll in these services.

**WHAT YOU CAN DO** We encourage you to remain vigilant by reviewing statements and explanations of benefits from healthcare providers and insurers. Under California law, you are also entitled to:

1. **Request a Free Credit Report:** You may obtain a free copy of your credit report once every 12 months from each of the three nationwide credit reporting agencies at [www.annualcreditreport.com](http://www.annualcreditreport.com) or by calling **(877) 322-8228**.
2. **Place a Security Freeze:** A security freeze prevents new credit from being opened in your name without the use of a PIN. It is free to place, lift, or remove.
