Dear Rancho Santa Fe School District Families,

On Tuesday, January 7, 2025, the Rancho Santa Fe School District was informed that PowerSchool, our student information system provider, was targeted in a cyberattack on December 22, 2024.

We want to assure you that we are actively working with PowerSchool to investigate this incident. PowerSchool is working with the FBI and conducting a full investigation to determine the scope of the breach. They have contained the situation and implemented measures to prevent further unauthorized access. The District will follow our cybersecurity protocol and work with our risk management and legal teams.

During the District's preliminary internal investigation it was determined the following information was accessed:
