## SPECIAL ALLEGATION 2 (Theft of Amount Over \$100,000.00)

It is further alleged that all Defendants, in the commission of the offenses alleged in Counts I through 140, with the intent to do so, committed theft in a value exceeding one hundred

thousand dollars (\$100,000) within the meaning of Penal Code Section 1203.045.

### SENTENCING FACTORS (Aggravating Factors)

The People further allege, pursuant to California Penal Code section 1170(b) and California Rules of Court 4.421(a), that for each of the following crimes charged, there exist circumstances in aggravation that are factors relating to the crime which are not elements of the individual crimes charged:

- 1. For Counts 1 through 140, the manner in which Defendants carried out the crimes indicates planning, sophistication, or professionalism (CA Rule of Court 4.421(a)(8));
- 2. For Counts 1 through 140, Defendant MACK induced others to participate in the commission of the crime or occupied a position of leadership or dominance of other participants in its commission (CA Rule of Court 4.421(a)(4));
- 3. For Counts 1 through 138, Defendants' crime sprees involved actual taking or damage of great monetary value (CA Rule of Court 4.421(a)(9)).

Pursuant to Penal Code Section 1054.5, subdivision (b), the People of the State of California hereby informally request that defense counsel provide to the People of the State of California all discovery as required by Penal Code Section 1054.3.
