On or about November 26, 2021, in the COUNTY of VENTURA, the crime of GRAND THEFT in violation of Penal Code section 487(d)(1), a felony, was committed by JEAN ANTHONY PARRET, who did knowingly and designedly, by a false and fraudulent representation and pretense, obtain money, labor and real and personal property by fraud from Bunnin Chevrolet of Santa Paula, specifically a 2022 Chevrolet Silverado 1500, which had a value exceeding nine hundred and fifty dollars (\$950).

COUNT 7

It is further alleged that prior to the commission of the offense or offenses alleged in the counts of this Complaint, defendant JEAN ANTHONY PARRET had been convicted of the following serious and/or violent felony, as defined in Penal Code section 667(d) and Penal Code section 1170.12(b), and is thus subject to sentencing pursuant to the provisions of Penal Code section 667(b)-(j) and Penal Code section 1170.12: County of Orange, Case No. 11WF0666, on May 17, 2012, a violation of Penal Code section 211.

FOURTH SPECIAL ALLEGATION

CIRCUMSTANCES IN AGGRAVATION

(CALIFORNIA RULE OF COURT RULE 4.421, P.C. § 1170(b)(2))

It is further alleged as to all defendants and charges, per Penal Code section 1170(b)(2) and within the meaning of Rule of Court Rule 4.421, that there exist circumstances in aggravation including the following factors:

- 1. The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, or professionalism (4.421(a)(8));
- 2. The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary value (4.421(a)(9));
- 3. The defendant has served a prior term in prison or county jail under Penal Code section 1170(h) (4.421(b)(3));
- 4. The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, post-release community supervision, or parole when the crime was committed (4.421(b)(4));
- 5. The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, post-release community supervision, or parole was unsatisfactory (4.421(b)(5)).
