26	Petitioners-Intervenors People of the State of California, ex rel. Attorney General Rob		
27	Bonta, and the California Department of Housing and Community Development (collectively,		
28	State) join Petitioner California Housing Defense Fund's motion for an appeal bond.		
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This Court issued a writ of mandate against the City, which the City has appealed. Under the Housing Accountability Act, "[i]f the local agency appeals the judgment of the trial court, the local agency shall post a bond, in an amount to be determined by the court, to the benefit of the plaintiff if the plaintiff is the project applicant." (Gov. Code, § 65589.5, subd. (m)(1).) The last clause does not apply in this case, because the project applicant is not the plaintiff, although it certainly makes sense that the project applicant — which is a party — should receive the benefit of the bond, since it bears the burden of the loss resulting from the appeal.

And, indeed, delay kills housing in California. Lengthy litigation, even if it is meritless, can result in the cancelation of a housing development due to inflation, changing interest rates, carrying costs, and expiring affordability funding. The Housing Accountability Act's bond requirement is crucial to address this problem, and was intended to do so. (Assemb. Comm. on Local Gov. and Cmty. Dev., Analysis of Sen. Bill 575, June 29, 2005 ["even if they are successful in a[]... court action against a local government, they often lose their projects as a result of increases in costs, loss of permits or land, or other consequences of the amount of time it took to get through the legal process."]). The Act should be "interpreted and implemented in a manner to afford the fullest possible weight to the interest of, and the approval and provision of, housing." (Gov. Code, § 65589.5, subd. (a)(2)(L).) Accordingly, the Court should order the City to post a bond in light of its appeal.
