FELONY COMPLAINT FOR ARREST WARRANT

21 The Attorney General of the State of California, certifying upon information and belief,
22 accuses the above-named Defendant of committing the following crimes in the County of Los
23 Angeles, State of California:

24 **COUNT 1**

25 **GRAND THEFT BY EMPLOYEE OR AGENT**

26 Between December 2022 and January 2024, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of
27 GRAND THEFT BY EMPLOYEE OR AGENT, a violation of § 487(b)(3) of the California

1 Penal Code, a Felony, was committed by defendant ADAM RICHARD WALKER, who while an
2 agent, servant, and employee of the United Firefighters of Los Angeles City Fire Foundation, did
3 unlawfully take money from the United Firefighters of Los Angeles City Fire Foundation, in an
4 amount which aggregates to a value of nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950) or more in any twelve
5 consecutive month period, specifically \$82,914.24, from a Fire Fighters Credit Union checking
6 account with account number ending in 7833.

7 **COUNT 2**

8 **FORGERY RELATING TO ITEMS EXCEEDING \$950 IN VALUE**

9 Between June 2024 and July 2025, in the County of Los Angeles, the crime of FORGERY
10 RELATING TO ITEMS EXCEEDING \$950 IN VALUE, a violation of § 470(d) of the
11 California Penal Code, a Felony, was committed by ADAM RICHARD WALKER, who did with
12 intent to defraud utter, publish, and attempt or offer to pass as true and genuine, receipts for
13 money and goods exceeding nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950), specifically \$6,213.74 in receipts
14 created using services provided by MakeReceipts.com, ExpenseFast.com, and PDFPro.us.com.

15 **FIRST SPECIAL ALLEGATION**

16 **AGGRAVATING CIRCUMSTANCES**

17 As to Counts 1 and 2, it is further alleged that the People will seek findings from the jury on
18 circumstances in aggravation **pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 4.421(a)** that:

19 (9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary value;

20 and

21 (11) The defendant took advantage of a position of trust or confidence to commit the
22 offense.

2 AND CORRECT AND THAT THIS COMPLAINT CONSISTS OF 2 COUNTS.
