20 It is further alleged pursuant to Penal Code section 186.11(a)(3), that LATOI PLEDGER,  
21 SAREENA STEVENSON, and VALENCIA STEVENSON, committed two or more related  
22 felonies to wit: the counts alleged against each of them in this complaint, a material element of  
23 which is fraud, involving a pattern of related felony conduct and the taking of, or resulted in the  
24 loss by another person or entity of, more than one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).

26 **SECOND SPECIAL ALLEGATION**

27 **[THEFT OF AMOUNT OVER \$100,000 (PENAL CODE SECTION 1203.045)]**

1 It is further alleged that LATOI PLEDGER, SAREENA STEVENSON, and VALENCIA  
2 STEVENSON, in the commission of the Grand Theft and Embezzlement counts alleged against  
3 them in this complaint, with the intent to do so, took funds of a value exceeding one hundred  
4 thousand dollars (\$100,000) within the meaning of Penal Code section 1203.045.

5 \* \* \* \* \*

6 **THIRD SPECIAL ALLEGATION**

7 **[TOLLING OF THE STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS (PC §§ 803(c), 803.5)]**

8 It is further alleged, as to all counts, and as described in Penal Code sections 803(c) and 803.5,  
9 that the charged violations were not discovered until September 17, 2017, at the earliest, by the  
10 victims in this case or by law enforcement. Counts 1-56 allege that Defendants defrauded and  
11 betrayed the trust of People Assisting the Homeless (PATH) to take funds and embezzle public  
12 monies designated for homeless assistance. PATH is a nonprofit organization whose mission is to  
13 end homelessness. In October of 2016, PATH was awarded a contract through the Los Angeles  
14 Homeless Services Authority (LAHSA) to serve people who are homeless. PATH assigned  
15 employees, including Defendants LaToi Pledger and Valencia Stevenson, to provide services to  
16 eligible clients under the LAHSA contract. Defendant Valencia Stevenson was a case manager,  
17 responsible for providing services to and requesting funds for eligible PATH clients; Defendant  
18 Pledger was a program manager, responsible for verifying documentation, including the  
19 homelessness of the participant, and approving fund requests. The LAHSA contract required any  
20 payments to be made directly to a property owner or management company. Defendant Sareena  
21 Stevenson is a relative of Defendant Valencia Stevenson; Defendant Valencia portrayed Defendant  
22 Sareena as a property manager to facilitate the charged offenses.

23 On or about January 17, 2017, Defendant Valencia submitted a referral to PATH for C'Hera  
24 G. who was an associate of Defendants Sareena and Valencia (I use Sareena and Valencia's first  
25 names to avoid confusion since they have the same last name). The referral attested that C'Hera  
26 was homeless, but in fact, Defendant Valencia knew that she was not homeless. On or about  
27 January 31, 2017, Defendant Valencia submitted a PATH fund request for C'Hera G. for rental  
28 assistance in the amount of \$3,060, which Defendant Pledger authorized. The request listed

1 Empire Investment Properties (EIP), an entity controlled by Defendant Sareena, as the landlord to  
2 be paid. With the request, Defendant Valencia submitted a W-9 form for EIP signed by Defendant  
3 Sareena on January 30, 2017. On or about February 7, 2017, Defendant Sareena deposited the  
4 \$3,060 check from PATH to a bank account that she operated in the name of EIP.

5 In the following months, Defendants submitted multiple additional referrals and assistance  
6 requests to PATH for persons they knew were not homeless and were thus ineligible for PATH  
7 assistance. Defendants received the PATH funds and used them for their own personal purposes  
8 or diverted the funds to their associates, instead of the purposes stated in the PATH requests. To  
9 conceal and perpetuate their fraud, Defendants falsified materials, including leases and income  
10 documents, which made Defendants' referrals and property managers appear eligible for PATH  
11 assistance. Because Defendant Valencia reported to Defendant Pledger, and because Defendant  
12 Pledger was able to approve Defendant Valencia's fund requests, their fraud was insulated.

13 After noticing an increase in funds spent in July of 2017, PATH's finance department began  
14 an internal review. On or about September 14, 2017, the review revealed discrepancies and  
15 PATH's finance department shared that information with Tescia U., PATH's regional director. On  
16 September 17, 2017, Tescia reviewed the information and recognized the name of one of the clients,  
17 Marcellas F., as someone she understood to be Defendant Pledger's boyfriend. Tescia learned that  
18 Defendant Valencia was assigned as Marcellas's PATH case manager and that Marcellas's  
19 application was approved by Defendant Pledger. Tescia became concerned that the application was  
20 fraudulent, and on September 18, 2017, secured all of Defendant Valencia's files from her office.

21 The next day, September 19, 2017, Tescia spoke with Defendants Pledger and Valencia at  
22 work. Tescia asked Defendant Valencia if there was anything she wanted to tell Tescia about her  
23 clients and she replied, "No." Tescia asked Defendant Pledger if she knew what was going on and  
24 Defendant Pledger said, "Nope, I have no idea." PATH placed Defendants Pledger and Valencia  
25 on administrative leave pending an internal review. On or about October 4, 2017, PATH reported  
26 the conduct to law enforcement. No victim of these violations and no law enforcement agency  
27 chargeable with the investigation and prosecution of said violations had actual or constructive  
28 knowledge of said violations before September 17, 2017.


