It is further alleged that ROBERT LEE JOHNSON, in the commission of the offenses alleged in Counts 1, 3, 5 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, 21, 23, 24, 25, 27, 30, 31, and 32, with the intent to do so, committed theft in a value exceeding one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars within the meaning of Penal Code section 1203.045, to wit: cigarettes, cash, designer purses, alcohol, ATMs, and goods with a total estimated value of six hundred and fifty thousand seven hundred and thirty-seven (\$680,737) dollars.

SPECIAL ALLEGATION 2

It is further alleged as to counts 1-5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, and 32, that pursuant to Penal Code Sections 1170.12(a) through 1170.12(d) and 667(b) through 667(i), the said defendant, ROBERT LEE JOHNSON, suffered the following prior convictions for a serious or violent felony: Penal Code section 211, Second Degree Robbery, on May 9, 2018, Superior Court of Alameda County case number 18-CR-002184.

SPECIAL ALLEGATION 3

AGGRAVATING FACTORS AS TO ROBERT LEE JOHNSON

As to Counts 1-5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31, and 32, the People further allege the following circumstances in aggravation pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 4.421:

- (a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, or professionalism;
- (a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary value;
- (b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult or sustained petitions in juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous or of increasing seriousness;
- (b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease community supervision, or parole when the crime was committed;
- (b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease community supervision, or parole was unsatisfactory.

VENUE

All charges are brought in Contra Costa County pursuant to Penal Code sections 786.5, 781, and 786, in that multiple offenses of theft involve the same defendants and substantially similar activity in each affected county as part of the defendants' coordinated criminal scheme. Jurisdiction also extends to all associated offenses connected together in their commission to the underlying theft offenses.

DNA SWAB

NOTE: Conviction of these offenses, as to Counts 1-5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 30, will require the said defendant, ROBERT LEE JOHNSON, to provide specimens and samples pursuant to Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime. Willful refusal to provide specimens and samples is a crime.

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 17, complainant further complains and says: On or about November 8, 2023, in the county of San Diego, the crime of BURGLARY, in violation of Penal Code section 459/460(b), a felony, was committed by, ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully enter Nordstrom located at 6997 Friars Rd., San Diego, CA, and committed theft exceeding a value of nine hundred and fifty (\$950) dollars, specifically, six Chanel purses with a total value of approximately one hundred and twenty thousand (\$120,000) dollars.

COUNT NINETEEN

GRAND THEFT

(PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 18, complainant further complains and says: On or about November 8, 2023, in the county of San Diego, the crime of GRAND THEFT, in violation of Section 487(a) of the Penal Code, a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid did willfully and unlawfully steal, take, carry, lead, and drive away the personal property of Nordstrom, specifically, six Chanel purses with a total value of approximately one hundred and twenty thousand (\$120,000) dollars.

COUNT TWENTY

RECEIPT OF STOLEN PROPERTY

(PENAL CODE SECTION 496(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 19, complainant further complains

and says: On or about November 8, 2023, in the county of San Diego, the crime of RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY, in violation of Penal Code section 496(a), a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who did willfully and unlawfully buy or receive property, exceeding nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950) in value, that had been stolen and/or obtained in a manner constituting theft or extortion and did conceal, sell, withhold, or aid in concealing, selling, or withholding property exceeding nine hundred and fifty dollars (\$950) in value, from the owner, specifically, six Chanel purses, knowing the property to be so stolen and obtained.

COUNT TWENTY-ONE

BURGLARY

(PENAL CODE SECTION 459/460(b))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 20, complainant further complains and says: On or about November 14, 2023, in the county of Solano, the crime of BURGLARY, in violation of Penal Code section 459/460(b), a felony, was committed by, ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully enter Cigarettes 4 Less, located at 2083 Solano Ave., Vallejo, CA, with the intent to commit larceny and any felony.

COUNT TWENTY-TWO

RECEIPT OF STOLEN PROPERTY

(PENAL CODE SECTION 496(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 21, complainant further complains and says: On or about November 14, 2023, in the County of Alameda, the crime of RECEIVING STOLEN PROPERTY, in violation of Penal Code section 496(a), a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who did willfully and unlawfully buy or receive

property, exceeding nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950) in value, that had been stolen and/or obtained in a manner constituting theft or extortion and did conceal, sell, withhold, or aid in concealing, selling, or withholding property exceeding nine hundred and fifty dollars (\$950) in value, from the owner, specifically, 92 cigarette boxes from Cigarettes 4 Less, knowing the property to be so stolen and obtained.

COUNT TWENTY-THREE

CARRYING A LOADED UNREGISTERED FIREARM IN PUBLIC

(PENAL CODE SECTION 25850(c)(6))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 22, complainant further complains and says: On or about November 14, 2023, in the County of Alameda, the crime of CARRYING A LOADED UNREGISTERED FIREARM IN PUBLIC, in violation of Section 25850(c)(6) of the Penal Code, a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully carry a loaded unregistered firearm, to wit: Glock 40 .40 caliber handgun, Serial Number: SRF221, in a vehicle in a public place.

COUNT TWENTY-FOUR

ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT

(PENAL CODE SECTION 490.4(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charges set forth in Counts 1, 3, 5 7, 9, 11, 13, 14, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, and 22, complainant further complains and says: On or about September 8, 2023, through November 14, 2023, in the counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Santa Clara, San Diego, San Joaquin, and Solano, the crime of ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT, in violation of Penal Code section 490.4(a), a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who did willfully and unlawfully act in concert with one or more persons to steal merchandise from one or more merchant's premises or online marketplace with the intent to sell, exchange, or return the

merchandise for value, in which the violations are committed on two or more separate occasions within a twelve month period, in which the aggregate value of the merchandise stolen, received, purchased, or possessed, is in excess of nine hundred and fifty (\$950) dollars, to wit: cigarettes, cash, designer purses, alcohol, and goods with a total estimated value of six hundred and fifty thousand seven hundred and thirty-seven (\$650,737) dollars.

COUNT TWENTY-FIVE

CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT

(PENAL CODE SECTION 182(a)(1))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charges set forth in Count 24, complainant further complains and says: On or about October 3, 2023, in the county of Contra Costa, the crime of CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT A CRIME, in violation of Penal Code section 182(a)(1), a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO MCDONALD, in that said defendants did unlawfully conspire together and with another person and person whose identity is unknown to commit the crime of ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT, a felony, in violation of Penal Code section 490.4(a); that pursuant to and for the purpose of carrying out the objectives and purpose of the aforesaid conspiracy the Defendants committed the following overt acts:

Overt Act 1

On October 3, 2023, Defendants Robert Lee Johnson and Quinn Jamari Edwards, along with additional unknown co-conspirators, unlawfully entered the Louis Vuitton store located at 1211 Broadway Plaza, Walnut Creek, CA, at approximately 4:20 a.m. and stole 66 items with a total value of two hundred and forty-six thousand and twenty-five (\$246,025) dollars.

Overt Act 2

On October 3, 2023, at approximately 5:30 a.m., Defendant Alejandro De Jesus McDonald received, photographed, and inventoried stolen merchandise from Louis Vuitton.

SPECIAL ALLEGATION 1

It is further alleged that ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, in the commission of the offenses alleged in Counts 1, 3, 5 7, 9, 11, 13, 14, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, and 25, with the intent to do so, committed theft in a value exceeding one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars within the meaning of Penal Code section 1203.045, to wit: cigarettes, cash, designer purses, alcohol, ATMs, and goods with a total estimated value of six hundred and fifty thousand seven hundred and thirty-seven (\$680,737) dollars.

SPECIAL ALLEGATION 2

AGGRAVATING FACTORS AS TO ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD

As to Counts 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11-25, the People further allege the following circumstances in aggravation pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 4.421:

- (a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, or professionalism;
- (a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary value;
- (b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult or sustained petitions in juvenile delinquency proceedings are numerous or of increasing seriousness;
- (b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease community supervision, or parole when the crime was committed;
- (b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease community supervision, or parole was unsatisfactory.

VENUE

All charges are brought in Contra Costa County pursuant to Penal Code sections 786.5, 781, and 786, in that multiple offenses of thest involve the same defendants and substantially similar activity in each affected county as part of the defendants' coordinated criminal scheme. Jurisdiction also extends to all associated offenses connected together in their commission to the underlying thest offenses.
