1 SPECIAL ALLEGATION 3

2 **AGGRAVATING FACTORS AS TO ROBERT LEE JOHNSON**

3 As to Counts 1-5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22, 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, 30, 31,
4 and 32, the People further allege the following circumstances in aggravation pursuant to California
5 Rules of Court, Rule 4.421:

6 (a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, or
7 professionalism;

8 (a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary value;

9 (b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult or sustained petitions in juvenile
10 delinquency proceedings are numerous or of increasing seriousness;

11 (b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease community
12 supervision, or parole when the crime was committed;

13 (b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease
14 community supervision, or parole was unsatisfactory.

15
16 VENUE

17 All charges are brought in Contra Costa County pursuant to Penal Code sections 786.5, 781,
18 and 786, in that multiple offenses of theft involve the same defendants and substantially similar
19 activity in each affected county as part of the defendants' coordinated criminal scheme. Jurisdiction
20 also extends to all associated offenses connected together in their commission to the underlying theft
21 offenses.

22
23 DNA SWAB

24 *NOTE:* Conviction of these offenses, as to Counts 1-5, 7, 8, 9, 11, 13, 15, 16, 17, 19, 20, 21, 22,
25 23, 24, 25, 26, 27, 28, and 30, will require the said defendant, ROBERT LEE JOHNSON, to
26 provide specimens and samples pursuant to Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the
27 specimens and samples is a crime. Willful refusal to provide specimens and samples is a crime.

4 **COUNT SIXTEEN**

5 **BURGLARY**

6 (PENAL CODE SECTION 459/460(b))

7 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of
8 crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 15, complainant further complains and says:
9 On or about October 18, 2023, in the county of Alameda, the crime of BURGLARY, in violation
10 of Penal Code section 459/460(b), a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS
11 MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully enter
12 Discount Cigarettes located at 7986 Amador Valley Blvd., Dublin, CA, with the intent to commit
13 larceny and any felony.

14
15 **COUNT SEVENTEEN**

16 **VANDALISM**

17 (PENAL CODE SECTION 594(b)(1))

18 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected
19 together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 16, complainant further complains
20 and says: On or about October 18, 2023, in the county of Alameda, the crime of VANDALISM,
21 in violation of Section 594(b)(1) of the Penal Code, a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO
22 DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully
23 and maliciously damage or destroy, real and personal property, not his/her own, to wit: Discount
24 Cigarettes, the amount of said damage being four hundred dollars (\$400.00) or more.

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COUNT EIGHTEEN

BURGLARY

(PENAL CODE SECTION 459/460(b))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 17, complainant further complains and says: On or about November 8, 2023, in the county of San Diego, the crime of BURGLARY, in violation of Penal Code section 459/460(b), a felony, was committed by, ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully enter Nordstrom located at 6997 Friars Rd., San Diego, CA, and committed theft exceeding a value of nine hundred and fifty (\$950) dollars, specifically, six Chanel purses with a total value of approximately one hundred and twenty thousand (\$120,000) dollars.

COUNT NINETEEN

GRAND THEFT

(PENAL CODE SECTION 487(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 18, complainant further complains and says: On or about November 8, 2023, in the county of San Diego, the crime of GRAND THEFT, in violation of Section 487(a) of the Penal Code, a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid did willfully and unlawfully steal, take, carry, lead, and drive away the personal property of Nordstrom, specifically, six Chanel purses with a total value of approximately one hundred and twenty thousand (\$120,000) dollars.

COUNT TWENTY

RECEIPT OF STOLEN PROPERTY

(PENAL CODE SECTION 496(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 19, complainant further complains

1 and says: On or about November 8, 2023, in the county of San Diego, the crime of RECEIVING
2 STOLEN PROPERTY, in violation of Penal Code section 496(a), a felony, was committed by
3 ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who did willfully and unlawfully buy or receive
4 property, exceeding nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950) in value, that had been stolen and/or
5 obtained in a manner constituting theft or extortion and did conceal, sell, withhold, or aid in
6 concealing, selling, or withholding property exceeding nine hundred and fifty dollars (\$950) in
7 value, from the owner, specifically, six Chanel purses, knowing the property to be so stolen and
8 obtained.

9
10 **COUNT TWENTY-ONE**

11 **BURGLARY**

12 (PENAL CODE SECTION 459/460(b))

13 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of
14 crimes and offenses as the charge set forth in Count 20, complainant further complains and says:
15 On or about November 14, 2023, in the county of Solano, the crime of BURGLARY, in violation
16 of Penal Code section 459/460(b), a felony, was committed by, ALEJANDRO DE JESUS
17 MCDONALD, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully enter
18 Cigarettes 4 Less, located at 2083 Solano Ave., Vallejo, CA, with the intent to commit larceny
19 and any felony.

20
21 **COUNT TWENTY-TWO**

22 **RECEIPT OF STOLEN PROPERTY**

23 (PENAL CODE SECTION 496(a))

24 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected
25 together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 21, complainant further complains
26 and says: On or about November 14, 2023, in the County of Alameda, the crime of RECEIVING
27 STOLEN PROPERTY, in violation of Penal Code section 496(a), a felony, was committed by
28 ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who did willfully and unlawfully buy or receive

1 property, exceeding nine hundred fifty dollars (\$950) in value, that had been stolen and/or
2 obtained in a manner constituting theft or extortion and did conceal, sell, withhold, or aid in
3 concealing, selling, or withholding property exceeding nine hundred and fifty dollars (\$950) in
4 value, from the owner, specifically, 92 cigarette boxes from Cigarettes 4 Less, knowing the
5 property to be so stolen and obtained.

6
7 **COUNT TWENTY-THREE**

8 **CARRYING A LOADED UNREGISTERED FIREARM IN PUBLIC**

9 (PENAL CODE SECTION 25850(c)(6))

10 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected
11 together in its commission with the charge set forth in Count 22, complainant further complains
12 and says: On or about November 14, 2023, in the County of Alameda, the crime of CARRYING
13 A LOADED UNREGISTERED FIREARM IN PUBLIC, in violation of Section 25850(c)(6) of
14 the Penal Code, a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who, at
15 the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully carry a loaded unregistered firearm,
16 to wit: Glock 40 .40 caliber handgun, Serial Number: SRF221, in a vehicle in a public place.

17
18 **COUNT TWENTY-FOUR**

19 **ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT**

20 (PENAL CODE SECTION 490.4(a))

21 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of
22 crimes and offenses as the charges set forth in Counts 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 14, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21,
23 and 22, complainant further complains and says: On or about September 8, 2023, through
24 November 14, 2023, in the counties of Alameda, Contra Costa, Santa Clara, San Diego, San
25 Joaquin, and Solano, the crime of ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT, in violation of Penal Code
26 section 490.4(a), a felony, was committed by ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, who did
27 willfully and unlawfully act in concert with one or more persons to steal merchandise from one or
28 more merchant's premises or online marketplace with the intent to sell, exchange, or return the

1 merchandise for value, in which the violations are committed on two or more separate occasions
2 within a twelve month period, in which the aggregate value of the merchandise stolen, received,
3 purchased, or possessed, is in excess of nine hundred and fifty (\$950) dollars, to wit: cigarettes,
4 cash, designer purses, alcohol, and goods with a total estimated value of six hundred and fifty
5 thousand seven hundred and thirty-seven (\$650,737) dollars.

6
7 **COUNT TWENTY-FIVE**

8 **CONSPIRACY TO COMMIT ORGANIZED RETAIL THEFT**

9 (PENAL CODE SECTION 182(a)(1))

10 For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense of the same class of
11 crimes and offenses as the charges set forth in Count 24, complainant further complains and says:
12 On or about October 3, 2023 , in the county of Contra Costa, the crime of CONSPIRACY TO
13 COMMIT A CRIME, in violation of Penal Code section 182(a)(1), a felony, was committed by
14 ALEJANDRO MCDONALD, in that said defendants did unlawfully conspire together and with
15 another person and person whose identity is unknown to commit the crime of ORGANIZED
16 RETAIL THEFT, a felony, in violation of Penal Code section 490.4(a); that pursuant to and for
17 the purpose of carrying out the objectives and purpose of the aforesaid conspiracy the Defendants
18 committed the following overt acts:

19 **Overt Act 1**

20 On October 3, 2023, Defendants Robert Lee Johnson and Quinn Janari Edwards, along
21 with additional unknown co-conspirators, unlawfully entered the Louis Vuitton store located at
22 1211 Broadway Plaza, Walnut Creek, CA, at approximately 4:20 a.m. and stole 66 items with a
23 total value of two hundred and forty-six thousand and twenty-five (\$246,025) dollars.

24 **Overt Act 2**

25 On October 3, 2023, at approximately 5:30 a.m., Defendant Alejandro De Jesus McDonald
26 received, photographed, and inventoried stolen merchandise from Louis Vuitton.
27
28

1 **SPECIAL ALLEGATION 1**

2 It is further alleged that ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, in the commission of the
3 offenses alleged in Counts 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 14, 16, 18, 19, 20, 21, 22, 24, and 25, with the
4 intent to do so, committed theft in a value exceeding one hundred thousand (\$100,000) dollars
5 within the meaning of Penal Code section 1203.045, to wit: cigarettes, cash, designer purses,
6 alcohol, ATMs, and goods with a total estimated value of six hundred and fifty thousand seven
7 hundred and thirty-seven (\$680,737) dollars.

8
9 **SPECIAL ALLEGATION 2**

10 **AGGRAVATING FACTORS AS TO ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD**

11 As to Counts 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11-25, the People further allege the following circumstances
12 in aggravation pursuant to California Rules of Court, Rule 4.421:

13 (a)(8) The manner in which the crime was carried out indicates planning, sophistication, or
14 professionalism;

15 (a)(9) The crime involved an attempted or actual taking or damage of great monetary value;

16 (b)(2) The defendant's prior convictions as an adult or sustained petitions in juvenile
17 delinquency proceedings are numerous or of increasing seriousness;

18 (b)(4) The defendant was on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease community
19 supervision, or parole when the crime was committed;

20 (b)(5) The defendant's prior performance on probation, mandatory supervision, postrelease
21 community supervision, or parole was unsatisfactory.

22
23 **VENUE**

24 All charges are brought in Contra Costa County pursuant to Penal Code sections 786.5, 781,
25 and 786, in that multiple offenses of theft involve the same defendants and substantially similar
26 activity in each affected county as part of the defendants' coordinated criminal scheme. Jurisdiction
27 also extends to all associated offenses connected together in their commission to the underlying theft
28 offenses.

1 DNA SWAB

2 *NOTE:* Conviction of these offenses, as to Counts 1, 2, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11-25, will require the said
3 defendants, ALEJANDRO DE JESUS MCDONALD, to provide specimens and samples pursuant
4 to Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime.
5 Willful refusal to provide specimens and samples is a crime.
