On or about, and between, November 1, 2018 and July 25, 2019, in the County of Santa Clara, defendant ARASH MALIAN PADIDAR, did unlawfully obtain and attempt to obtain a controlled substance, to wit HYDROCODONE (Norco), which is a narcotic drug classified in Schedule II, and did procure and attempt to procure the administration of and prescription for said controlled substance by fraud, deceit, misrepresentation and subterfuge and by concealment of a material fact, in violation of Health & Safety Code section 11173(a), a felony; to wit, acts involving MGC.

#### COUNT 3

# Health & Safety Code § 11153(a), Felony Issuing a Prescription for a Controlled Substance Without a Legitimate Medical Purpose

16 months, 2 years, or 3 years

On or about, and between, January 16, 2020 and May 27, 2020, in the County of Santa Clara, defendant ARASH MALIAN PADIDAR, did knowingly and unlawfully issue prescriptions

for controlled substances to I.M.S, to wit, HYDROCODONE (Norco), without a legitimate medical purpose and outside the usual course of professional practice and treatment, in violation of Health & Safety Code section 11153, subdivision (a), a felony.

On or about, and between, January 16, 2020 and May 27, 2020, in the County of Santa Clara, defendant ARASH MALIAN PADIDAR, did unlawfully obtain and attempt to obtain a controlled substance, to wit HYDROCODONE (Norco), which is a narcotic drug classified in Schedule II, and did procure and attempt to procure the administration of and prescription for said controlled substance by fraud, deceit, misrepresentation and subterfuge and by concealment of a material fact, in violation of Health & Safety Code section 11173(a), a felony; to wit, acts involving I.M.S.

## Health & Safety Code § 11368(a), Felony Forging and Issuing a Prescription 16 months, 2, or 3 years

On or about and between January 23, 2018 and October 2, 2020, in the County of Santa Clara, the defendant ARASH MALIAN PADIDAR, did unlawfully forge, alter, and issue a prescription bearing a forged and fictitious signature for a narcotic drug, to wit, HYDROCODONE (Norco), in violation of section 11368, subdivision (a) of the Health and Safety Code, a felony.

### Penal Code § 530.5(a), Felony Unlawful Use of Personal Identifying Information 16 months, 2, or 3 years

P. C. and used that information for an unlawful purpose and to obtain, and attempt to obtain credit, goods, services, real property, and medical information without the consent of DR. P. C. in violation of section 530.5, subdivision (a) of the Penal Code, a felony.

#### COUNT 7

Penal Code § 182(a)(1), Felony Conspiracy to Commit a Crime (HS 11173) 16 months, 2, or 3 years

#### Overt Act #97

On or about August 31, 2020, a prescription for Norco (hydrocodone bitartrate-acetominophen) 10/325 mg (quantity 100) was filled and sold at the Walgreens Pharmacy located at 2105 Morrill Avenue, San Jose, CA, in the name of Jacob Market.

#### Overt Act #98

On or about and between August 31, 2020 and October 7, 2020, the defendant, ARASH MALIAN PADIDAR created and maintained a note on his iPhone, documenting the August 31st Norco prescription he wrote to Jacob Marian.

# SPECIAL ALLEGATION — TOLLING OF STATUTE OF LIMITATIONS Penal Code Sections 801,5, 803,5 and 803(c)

It is further alleged as to Counts 1 through 7:

- The offenses are felonies which have a material element of fraud and breach of fiduciary obligation;
  - The offenses were not discovered until between August 25, 2019 and October 1, 2019;
- No victim of the offenses and no law enforcement agencies chargeable with the
  investigation and prosecution of the offenses had actual or constructive knowledge of the
  offenses prior to August 25, 2019 when it was discovered;

- 3. The offenses were discovered when MGC contacted San Jose Police Detective Tony Vera and the U.S. Drug Enforcement Agency (DEA) one to two months after she was fired by Padidar on 7/25/2019. MGC reported what she had witnessed and experienced with Padidar during the time she worked for him from June 2018 until July 25, 2019.
- 4. The offenses could not have been discovered earlier with reasonable diligence because Padidar and his conspirators used fraudulent means to obtain prescription Norco and concealed that information. Padidar wrote prescriptions for Norco to various individuals who filled the prescriptions at different pharmacies. Padidar used Dr. ( 's name and DEA number to write prescriptions to himself, his wife and his father every month. By spreading around the prescriptions in the name of various individuals and even using another doctor's prescribing information, he fraudulently obtained the medication and concealed his activities from law enforcement and Dr. C.

Further, attached and incorporated by reference is an Affidavit in Support of Arrest Warrant and Complaint completed by a sworn peace officer from the California Department of Justice which the complainant believes establishes probable cause for the arrest of defendant ARASH MALIAN PADIDAR, for the above listed crimes. Wherefore, A WARRANT OF ARREST IS REQUESTED.
