18 The ATTORNEY GENERAL OF THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA accuses defendant KATRIN  
19 GOLIAN of the following crime:

20 **COUNT 1 - PRICE GOUGING**

21 1. On or about April 24, 2020, in the County of Los Angeles, State of California, KATRIN  
22 GOLIAN doing business as RxAll Pharmacy, knowingly refused or willfully neglected to obey a  
23 lawful order, to wit: Executive Order N-44-20 by charging an unconscionably excessive price for  
consumer goods and/or medical or emergency supplies, to wit: KN95 personal protective masks,  
in violation of Government Code, section 8665, a misdemeanor.

24 2. On March 4, 2020, Governor Gavin Newsom proclaimed a statewide State of Emergency in  
25 response to the COVID-19 pandemic. On April 3, 2020, as a further response to the pandemic,  
26 Governor Newsom issued Executive Order N-22-20 to extend prohibitions against price-gouging,  
27 Paragraph 3 of this Order, provides that any business that did not offer for sale consumer goods  
28 and/or medical or emergency supplies prior to February 4, 2020, shall not sell such items at an  
unconsciously excessive price during the period April 4, 2020 to September 4, 2020. This Order  
further states that a price is unconsciously excessive if that price is more that 50 percent greater  
than the amount paid by the seller for the item.
