(VEHICLE CODE SECTION 2800.2(a))

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charges set forth in Counts 18 and 19, complainant further complains and says: On or about August 26, 2022, in the County of Contra Costa, the crime of RECKLESS EVADING, in violation of Section 2800.2(a) of the Vehicle Code, a felony, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, operated a motor vehicle while willfully fleeing or otherwise attempting to elude a pursuing officer in a motor vehicle, Contra Costa Sheriff's Deputy Daniel Harper, and operated said vehicle in a willful and wanton disregard for the safety of persons or property.

For a further and separate cause of complaint, being a different offense but connected together in its commission with the charges set forth in Counts 18, 19 and 20, complainant further complains and says: On or about August 26, 2022, in the County of Contra Costa, the crime of CARRYING A LOADED UNREGISTERED FIREARM IN PUBLIC, in violation of Section 25850(c)(6) of the Penal Code, a felony, was committed by SIRRON CROSKEY, who, at the time and place last aforesaid, did willfully and unlawfully carry a loaded unregistered firearm, to wit: Black Semi-automatic .45A Glock 30S Pistol Serial Number: BELT464 in a vehicle in a public place.

VENUE

These charges are brought in Contra Costa County pursuant to Penal Code sections 786.5 and 781 in that the multiple offenses of theft involve the same defendant and substantially similar activity in each affected county as part of Defendant's coordinated criminal scheme. Jurisdiction also extends to all associated offenses connected together in their commission to the underlying theft offenses.

STATUS ALLEGATION

MANDATORY STATE PRISON INCARCERATION: The said defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, is hereby notified as to Counts 2, 4, 6, 10, 12, 15 and 19, that the above offenses are violent felonies within the meaning of Penal Code section 667.5(c), and that pursuant to Penal Code sections 1170(h)(3) and 1170(f), an executed sentence for the offense(s) herein charged against said defendant shall be served in the state prison.

MANDATORY STATE PRISON INCARCERATION: The said defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, is hereby notified as to Counts 2, 4, 6, 7, 10, 12, 15, 16 and 19, that the above offense(s) are serious felonies within the meaning of Penal Code section 1192.7(c), and that pursuant to Penal Code sections 1170(h)(3) and 1170(f), an executed sentence for the offense(s) herein charged against said defendant shall be served in the state prison.

NOTE: Conviction of these offenses, as to Counts 2, 4, 6 - 21, will require the said defendant, SIRRON CROSKEY, to provide specimens and samples pursuant to Penal Code section 296. Willful refusal to provide the specimens and samples is a crime. Willful refusal to provide specimens and samples is a crime.
